## **Before The Reunion:**

- Prepare your heart for worship. (Do something that stirs your affections for Jesus.)
- Gather communion elements (Substitutes are ok if you're low on wine, juice or bread.)
- Print out your kid's activity pages (This week we have preschool, younger and older kids!)
- No pressure here AT ALL, but this may be a good time to give online if you don't have recurring gifts set up in Planning Center and you want to worship God in this way. ## **Liturgy:**

Another thing we've learned about family worship is that it might be helpful to press pause in order to keep everyone in your family engaged and on the same page. With that in mind here is the order of worship so that your family can consider the best times to press pause.

- First Song (Call To Worship)
- Welcome, Opportunities & Offering
- Second Song (Confession of Sin)
- Corporate Confession of Sin
- THIS IS A GREAT TIME TO PUSH PAUSE!
  - Set up kids with activities, refill your coffee and take a bathroom break
- Sermon
- Communion
  - Husbands and dads this is a unique opportunity for you to serve your family
- Third Song (Redemption)
- Fourth Song (Restoration)
