Before The Reunion:

Here are some recommendations we have for you as you prepare for worshipping God as a family on Sunday mornings during our Indoor Reunions:

- Please remember to bring masks for each person in your family (over age 2) as we are requiring them to be worn during the Reunion. (One-time use masks will be available for those who don't have one.)
- Our chairs have been rearranged so that each row is at least 6 feet apart. Please go to our website at www.harvest.city to let us know if you plan on worshipping with us so that we can put together a safe seating arrangement.
- Because we are striving for a touch-free environment, we won't be taking an offering. No pressure here AT ALL, but this may be a good time to give online if you don't have recurring gifts set up in Planning Center and you want to worship God in this way. You can also use this link to give to our COVID-19 Fund if you'd like to support those on the front lines in health care or those hurting financially as a result of this pandemic. - Please consider parking EVERY OTHER spot in the parking lot.
- Please use hand sanitizer on your way into church.
- There will be communion elements placed under each chair by a person using gloves before the Reunion.
- There will be only one person at a time in the bathrooms.
- Please follow One Way signs in the building and practice social distancing in all spaces.

Harvest City Kids:

- Childcare will be provided for kids ages 0-5. Please park in the lower parking lot and enter through the east doors. After checking in, a volunteer will escort your child to their room and bring them back to the check-in table after the Reunion. We ask that parents remain behind the check-in table and do not enter any of the children's rooms.
- Please check your child's temperature at home and do not check your child into Harvest City kids if they gave a fever, cough, sore throat, or runny nose. Everyone will be asked to wash their hands or use hand sanitizer when entering the classroom. We will also take frequent hand washing breaks.
- Every volunteer will wear a mask at all times and children over the age of 2 should wear a mask.
- For kids ages 5 and above, Activity Packets will be provided.

After The Reunion:

Please greet the new people in a socially distanced manner and exit the building following the One Way signs.
