

# tips to prep your home for PHOTOGRAPHY



## curb appeal

Remove all vehicles, boats, etc. from driveway(s) and do not park in front of house if possible.

Move garbage cans out of sight.

Remove/hide garden tools, hoses, etc.

Remove/hide pool equipment and supplies.

Remove all children's toys, bikes, etc.

Clean up after your pets.



## all over the home

Ensure all lightbulbs are working.

Declutter, declutter, declutter!

Remove throw rugs, runners from entry, kitchen, bathrooms.

Replace any burned out light bulbs.

Conceal any exposed electrical cords.



## kitchen

Clear countertops of clutter and remove any small appliances.

Clear all items from front/sides of fridge.

Clean major appliances and wipe down counters.



## living room & dining room


Remove all paper clutter.

Hide remotes, game systems, computers, etc.

Conceal all exposed cables as best as possible.

Remove clutter from bookshelves, tables, cabinets.

Move trashcans out of view.



## bathrooms


Clear all personal items off countertops.

Hang or fold fresh linen.

Remove ALL products from the shower/tub area.

Close the lid on all toilet seats.

Clean mirrors.



## bedrooms

Make all beds and tidy shelves/

Clothes should be hung, folded, and put away.

Remove excess items from bedside tables - books, magazines, pictures, clocks, radios, etc.

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
