

Dairy Regulatory Official's Organization Adopts New Name: National Association of Dairy Regulatory Officials (NADRO)

The organization representing each state's dairy regulatory officials announced in 2009 that their membership had approved its new name, the *National Association* of *Dairy Regulatory Officials* (NADRO).

Formerly known as the Dairy Division of NASDA, the organization was founded in 1957 and has evolved along with the nation's dairy industry. The new name more clearly conveys the membership's composition and areas of expertise. Each state's dairy regulatory structure is unique with approximately 30 dairy agencies being located in departments of agriculture. The remaining agencies are located in departments of health along with a limited number of states having programs partitioned among multiple agencies.

NADRO's objectives are to protect the health, welfare and interests of dairy product consumers and to promote unity and efficiency in the application of dairy regulatory procedures.

The Annual Meeting takes place during July of each year and is regularly attended by industry representatives. National




