
Participation on Councils and Committees:

The goal of NCIMS Councils and committees is to advance the mission of the Conference – to assure the safest possible milk supply for all the people – and requires strong commitment by those involved, including preparation for and active participation during all meetings. Active participation includes attending scheduled meetings or conference calls, contributing to dialogue and asking questions, and identifying, proposing, or evaluating potential solutions. Assignment to a Council or committee involves more than simply providing comment or perspective, it is working in the collaborative and cooperative spirit characteristic of the Conference, and provides an

ADULTERATION PREVENTION STUDY COMMITTEE

THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE IS CHARGED TO IDENTIFY AND DEVELOP APPROPRIATE STRATEGIES TO PREVENT CONTAMINATION OF GRADE "A" MILK AND/OR MILK PRODUCTS WITH CHEMICAL SANITIZERS AFTER THE CIP PROCESS. IN DEVELOPING PREVENTION STRATEGIES, THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE WILL, AT LEAST, CONSIDER:

- WHICH GRADE "A" MILK AND/OR MILK PRODUCTS SHOULD BE ADDRESSED THROUGH THE PREVENTION STRATEGIES;

Proposal 207- 48 Hour Notice


The Conference requests the Chair to assign this proposal to an NCIMS standing committee, special committee, or ad hoc committee as approved by the NCIMS Executive Board.


The assigned committee will report on their activities at the next meeting of the NCIMS Conference.
