

- THE LIAISON COMMITTEE REQUESTS THE CHAIR TO ASSIGN THIS PROPOSAL TO AN NCIMS STANDING COMMITTEE, SPECIAL COMMITTEE, OR AD HOC COMMITTEE AS APPROVED BY THE NCIMS EXECUTIVE BOARD.
- THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE IS CHARGED TO WORK COOPERATIVELY WITH FDA TO DEVELOP A PILOT PROGRAM WHICH WILL ESTABLISH A REGULATORY FRAMEWORK TO FIND EFFICIENCIES IN INSPECTION ACTIVITIES FOR FACILITIES THAT MANUFACTURE BOTH GRADE "A" AND NON-GRADE "A" PRODUCTS AND BE IMPLEMENTED BY FDA AND THE PARTICIPATING STATES.
- IN DEVELOPING THE DETAILS OF THE INSPECTIONAL MODEL(S) TO PILOT, THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE WILL, AT LEAST, CONSIDER: THE REGULATORY AUTHORITIES OF STATE REGULATORY AGENCIES, THE ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR PILOT CONSIDERATION, THE TYPES OF NON-GRADE "A" PRODUCTS MANUFACTURED IN DUAL-GRADE FACILITIES, THE RESOURCE NEEDS AND POTENTIAL HURDLES LIKELY TO BE ENCOUNTERED, AND THE METRICS FOR EVALUATING SUCCESS.

- WHEN IMPLEMENTED, THE PILOT PROGRAM WILL MEET THE AGENCY'S COMMITMENT TO THE NCIMS OF
 IDENTIFYING ADDITIONAL WAYS TO MAXIMIZE STATE AND FEDERAL RESOURCES AND TO CREATE GREATER
 EFFICIENCIES THROUGH ITS OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FDA FOOD SAFETY MODERNIZATION ACT WHILE
 MAINTAINING THE HIGH SAFETY OF THE U.S. MILK SUPPLY.
- FDA SHALL INFORM AND CONFER WITH THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE TO ANSWER QUESTIONS AND ADDRESS CONCERNS TO PROVIDE CLARITY AND TRANSPARENCY AT A FREQUENCY DETERMINED BY THE NCIMS EXECUTIVE BOARD. A COMPLETE REPORT OF THE PILOT PROGRAM WILL BE SHARED AT THE 2021 CONFERENCE.
- IN RECOGNITION THAT FDA IS STRONGLY COMMITTED TO DEVELOPING AND IMPLEMENTING THE DAIRY INSPECTION PILOT PROGRAM AND STANDS READY TO WORK IN A COLLABORATIVE SPIRIT ON THE FRAMEWORK FOR THIS PILOT PROGRAM IMMEDIATELY WITH THE ASSIGNED COMMITTEE, THE LIAISON COMMITTEE REQUESTS AN EFFECTIVE DATE OF THE RECEIPT AND ACCEPTANCE OF FDA CONCURRENCE AT THE NEXT NCIMS EXECUTIVE BOARD MEETING AFTER THE CONFERENCE.

- LIMITED SCOPE
 - Defined in FDA Compliance Program Guidance Manual 7303.040
 - REFERENCES TERM "BROAD ASSESSMENT"
 - CONDUCTED FACILITY WIDE

- Key Issues:
 - LIMITED SCOPE
 - FIELD INSPECTION STAFF <u>SHOULD NOT</u> CONDUCT THEIR OWN HAZARD ANALYSIS <u>OR REVIEW</u>

 <u>WRITTEN FOOD SAFETY PLANS</u>, INCLUDING THE FACILITY'S HAZARD ANALYSIS, PREVENTIVE CONTROL

 PROGRAMS, SUPPLY-CHAIN PROGRAMS, OR RECALL PLAN, AS PART OF THEIR BROAD ASSESSMENT.
 - FIELD INSPECTION STAFF SHOULD <u>NOTIFY DIVISION MANAGEMENT WHEN EGREGIOUS CONDITIONS</u>

 <u>ARE OBSERVED</u> PERTAINING TO THE CONTROL OF SIGNIFICANT HAZARDS TO DETERMINE WHETHER A

 FULL SCOPE PCHF INSPECTION IS WARRANTED. DO NOT CONDUCT A LIMITED SCOPE PCHF

 INSPECTION WHEN ENVIRONMENTAL SAMPLING IS BEING CONDUCTED DURING THE INSPECTION.

 ENVIRONMENTAL INSPECTIONS COVERING PROCESSES SUBJECT TO SUBPART C MUST BE EITHER

 FULL SCOPE PCHF OR PCHF FOLLOW-UP INSPECTIONS.



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GRADE A & NGA PILOT 2.0

March 16, 2022-Liaison sends 5-page letter to FDA outlining:

- NO OTHER COMMODITY CREATED A FSMA CARVE
 OUT BASED UPON GRADE.
- REQUESTS LIMITED SCOPE BE INCORPORATED
 DAIRY PROGRAM WIDE (ALL GRADES) TO SEEK
 EQUITY IN THE COMMODITY.
- APPENDIX T AS WRITTEN (W/FDA AT THE TABLE)
 HAS BEEN DEEMED TO BE EQUIVALENT TO
 21CFR117 PCHF (FULL-Scope).
- APPENDIX T IS MASSIVELY OVERBUILT WITH FDA'S "GAME CHANGING" LIMITED SCOPE APPROACH.

APRIL 4, 2022-FDA RESPONDS TO LIAISON LETTER OUTLINING:

- AGREES TO A 2-SCOPE APPROACH FOR APPENDIX T AUDITS.
- RESPONDED THAT JC-1 PILOT BELONGS TO THE LIAISON COMMITTEE AND IF THE LC WISHES TO PILOT A DUAL GRADE PILOT UTILIZING LIMITED SCOPE, IT CAN DO SO. (REQUEST SUBMITTED 5/11/22)
- CURRENTLY WORKING TO GET A TIMELINE ON FDA'S APPENDIX T ALIGNMENT TO THE AGENCY'S CURRENT POLICY USING THE LIMITED SCOPE INSPECTION SCHEME.
- New Phase of exploration is causing a revisit and recreation of the selected pilot states and approaches.
