

Explanation of Payouts in Roulette:

The Types of Bets Made in Roulette:

Payouts are in ().

- A – Straight Up Bet- Directly on the Number (35-1)
- B - Split Bet – Split between 2 Numbers (17 to 1)
- C - Street Bet – A wager placed on the Outside of a Row covering 3 numbers (11 to 1)
- D- Corner Bet – A wager placed on a “Corner” of 4 numbers (8 to 1)
- E- Double Street Bet – A wager is placed on the Outside but in the middle of Two Streets covering 6 Numbers (5 to 1)
- F- Basket Bet – A rare bet similar to a Double Street but ONLY covers 5 numbers 0,00,1,2,3. (6 to 1)
- G. Column Bet – A wager placed at the bottom of either Column 1, 2, or 3. (2 to 1)
- H. Dozens Bet – a wager placed in the numbers 1-12, 13-24, or 25-36. (2 to 1)

- I. Odd/Even Bet – Wager placed representing if a number lands on an Even or Odd number (1 to 1)
- J. High or Low Numbers Bet – Low numbers are 1-18 and High numbers are 19-36 (1 to 1)
- K. The famous “Red or Black Bet” – Wager is placed on either one of these Colors (Red or Black) (1 to 1)
