
AgrowTea™ – Foliar Application on Broccoli – Agronomist Notes High Yields relative to control plot.

AgrowTea is the nutrient liquid extract acquired after fermenting agricultural crop waste.



"Broccoli weigh-in As you know, we applied a foliar treatment once a week for 6 weeks at the 50-1 dilution using 41.25 gals of AgroTea per acre equivalent.

We have harvested the initial heads and the treated area averaged 1.1 lbs while the untreated or check area averaged .53.

We will have an additional harvest of side shoots which is yet unknown. Having larger main heads could reduce side shoot weight, however that is unlikely. Having a smaller head on the untreated area could result in heavier side shoots which might make up some of the difference.

Visually, there is a remarkable difference in the plant size and conformation. Good uniformity in both plots. So, this trial is a pleasant surprise.

The treated area is equivalent to 4.65 tons per acre, definitely on the high side for organic production on a dry year or any year."
