Beach Information

BEACH TAGS

All persons 12 years of age and over are required to display tags from Saturday of Memorial Day Weekend through Monday of Labor Day Weekend, 10am to 5pm.

Beach tag prices are as follows:

Seasonal tags through May 31 \$35.00 Seasonal tags beginning June 1 \$40.00 Weekly tags (Sat. through Sat.) \$17.00 Daily tags \$8.00

Veterans tags are free. ID required.

Seasonal, weekly and daily tags may be purchased at our Beach Tag Office, 95th Street & the Beach. 609.368.6805. And from inspectors on the beach or during the summer season.

POLICIES & RESTRICTIONS

Alcohol, glass bottles and fire are prohibited on our beaches. No sleeping is permitted between sunset and sunrise.

PROTECTED BEACHES

Our lifeguards are on duty from 10am to 5pm from Memorial Day to Labor Day. Protected bathing beaches are 81st, 83rd, 86th, 87th, 90th, 93rd, 94th, 95th, 96th, 100th, 102nd, 103rd, 105th, 108th, 110th, 112th, 113th, 116th, 117th, 120th and 122nd.

- Swimming and rafting beaches are all designated beaches except 81st, 86th, 105th, 110th, 112th, and 122nd Streets.
- Surfing and surfboards (with leases attached) are permitted at the beaches at 81st and 110th Streets only.
- Kayaks are permitted at 122nd Street through 126th Street only, and life jackets must be worn at all times while in the water.



Beach Information

- Sailcraft must be licensed and beached at designated areas only.
- Vehicles are permitted on the beach by permit only from October 1 through March 31st. For information regarding permits, call 609.368.5102.
 Permits are issued the day after Labor Day until March the following year.

HANDICAPPED ACCESS

There are ramps to the beach at 80th, 83rd, 88th, 92nd, 95th, 101st, 103rd, 105th, 111th & 119th Streets. Wheelchair users can follow a path to the water's edge at 95th Street.

*There is no charge for metered parking who properly display a handicapped windshield placard or license plate.

SURF CHAIRS

A total of 6 chairs are available at our Beach Tag Office. There is no charge for use. Reservations are strongly recommended. Call 609.368.6805.

BEACHFRONT PARKING

There is free beachfront parking at 80-83rd Streets and 122 Street, with an additional free lot at 94th Street & Second Ave. Beachfront lots at 95-96th Streets are pay-to-park with ParkMobile.

BEACH RESTROOMS

There are restrooms in the beachfront parking lots at 95th and 122nd Streets. Our comfortable public restrooms and family changing room are located at Water Tower Plaza, 95th Street and Second Avenue.

DOGS ON THE BEACH

Dogs are permitted on the beach from 7pm to sunset, Friday of Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Monday. In the "off season," leashed dogs are permitted on the beach at any time. Dogs are never permitted at our Stone Harbor Point Conservation Area. Picking up after your dog is mandatory.



Beach & Beyond

STONE HARBOR POINT

Located at the southern tip of Stone Harbor, you'll find a virtually deserted, pristine stretch of beach with sandbars, salt marshes and mud flats. The Point is where the ocean meets the bay with an ever-changing landscape, alive with birds and nature. It is a designated conservation area, including restricted and protected areas. It's a great place to walk, surf fish, beachcomb & birdwatch. No dogs are allowed at The Point.

STONE HARBOR MARINA

Our marina at 81st Street has a public boat ramp, kayak ramps, a public fishing and crabbing pier, restrooms, a pump-out waste station and free parking. Boat ramp fees apply and can be paid through ParkMobile. Contact the Recreation Department for more information, 609.368.1210.

STONE HARBOR BIRD SANCTUARY

A National Landmark since 1965, our bird sanctuary at 114h Street is comprised of 21 acres of maritime forest, wetlands, a spring-fed fresh water pond and meadow system. The preserve swarms with birds and butterflies and offers a self-guided informational walking tour. Docent lead walks are offered on weekends.

DOWNTOWN PARKING

Throughout our business district, designated parking spaces and lots require payment from May 1st through September 30th, 10am to 9pm. Stone Harbor uses **ParkMobile**. Directions for using the app or scanning the QR code are available throughout the parking zones.

Free parking is available at the 94th Street & Second Avenue Parking Lot. Residential parking is free.

BEACH PARKING

Our 95th-96th Street beach parking lot meters are active from May 1 through September 30th from 10am to 5pm. Free parking is available at our Point Parking Lot at 122nd Street & the Beach, and our beach-front parking spaces from 80th-82nd Streets.

BICYCLE SAFETY

Bikes and skateboards are not permitted on the roadway in the business district from the last Saturday in June through Labor Day between 6pm and midnight.

No bicycles, skateboards, roller blades, or scooters are allowed on the sidewalk in the business district at any time. Cyclists must obey all traffic rules. When bicycling after dark, bikes must be equipped with a white blinking light. Persons under the age of 17 are required to wear an approved helmet when cycling, roller skating, in-line.
