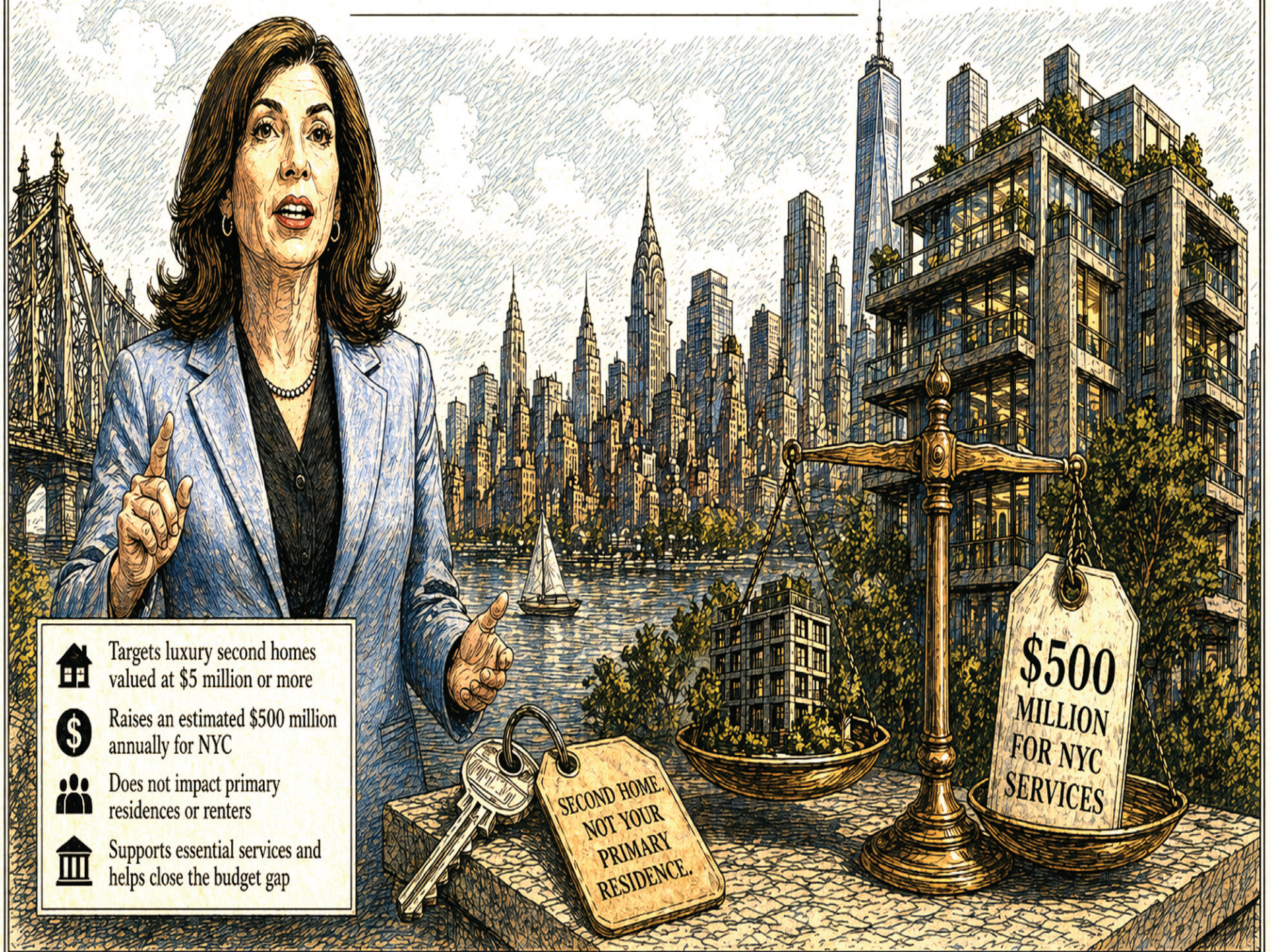

## HOCHUL PROPOSES PIED-À-TERRE TAX ON \$5 MILLION+ SECOND HOMES IN NYC



-  Targets luxury second homes valued at \$5 million or more
-  Raises an estimated \$500 million annually for NYC
-  Does not impact primary residences or renters
-  Supports essential services and helps close the budget gap

New York State Governor Kathy Hochul has announced a proposal to create a new “*piéd-à-terre*” tax targeting luxury second homes in New York City valued at \$5 million or more, a move aimed at generating revenue while avoiding broader tax increases on residents.

The proposal would allow New York City to impose an annual surcharge on high-value secondary residences owned by non-residents, with the goal of raising approximately \$500 million per year to help close the city’s budget gap. Officials say the measure is designed to ensure that ultra-wealthy property owners who benefit from the city contribute more to its financial stability.

Hochul emphasized that the tax would not impact full-time New York residents, maintaining her position against raising income or corporate taxes.

**“If you can afford a \$5 million second home that sits empty most of the year, you can afford to contribute like every other New Yorker,”** Hochul said in a statement.

The proposal specifically targets properties that are not primary residences and are often unoccupied for much of the year. Approximately 13,000 such properties could be affected, according to estimates, with the tax structured as a surcharge based on property value.

New York City Mayor Zohran Mamdani, who has pushed for increased taxes on the wealthy, voiced strong support for the plan, framing it as a step toward fiscal balance and fairness.

“The super wealthy... benefit from New York City’s real estate market, but not have to pay back into that same city in the way that they should,” Mamdani said, arguing that the tax would ensure those benefiting from the city contribute to the services that sustain it.

City officials say the revenue generated would help fund essential services and address a multibillion-dollar budget shortfall, while also supporting housing-related initiatives.

The measure still requires approval from the State Legislature, where details such as the exact tax rate and structure remain under negotiation. If enacted, it would mark the first tax of its kind in New York, targeting high-end secondary properties rather than primary homes or rental units.

Supporters argue the proposal is a targeted way to raise revenue without burdening working residents, while critics warn it could impact the luxury real estate market and discourage investment. As budget negotiations continue in Albany, the *piéd-à-terre* tax has emerged as a central component of efforts to close New York City’s fiscal gap without broader tax increases.

# CONVINCING SOMEONE TO GET MENTAL HEALTH HELP

There are many reasons why some people are reluctant to get help for their mental health or addiction issues. In addition, many people are not sure what to do when encouraging someone to get the help they need for their mental health. As a result, here are seven suggestions on how to convince a person struggling to get some assistance.

1. **Talk to the person instead of talking at them:** Nobody wants to be lectured or yelled at. The person who is struggling is scared and they need help in overcoming their fears and resistance to getting some guidance. Treat others the way you would want to be treated if the roles were reversed.
2. **Find out why the person won't get help:** Ask the individual who is struggling the reasons why they are reluctant to get some assistance. Although most people may not admit it, a sense of fear of the unknown and/or some kind of frustration are usually the main factors. It might take a few tries, however, try to find out what is stopping your friend from getting treatment.
3. **Address the reasons why the individual won't get help:** Once you get the reasons why he or she won't get some help, the next step is to find the ways to address those factors that are preventing the individual from getting assistance. Addressing one's fears and concerns may convince them to take some action that will get their life back on track.
4. **Get some advice from a professional:** Talk to your doctor or a mental health counselor for recommendations on how you can help someone who is struggling. A medical professional in the mental health field will be able to give you some ideas and options that you can use to help convince someone you know to get some help.
5. **Find someone who understands:** Try to find someone who used to struggle with their mental health for their advice. For example, a person who used drugs and alcohol in the past could use their past experiences and insights to convince the individual to seek treatment. A person who used to struggle with addiction or their mental health may be better able to relate to the person who is struggling.
6. **Get them to attend a support group:** Another way to convince someone to get help is to get them to go to a mental health support group. This may or may not work depending on the individual, but it is still worth a try. A person who goes to a support group can at least listen to those who are also struggling, which may convince the person to get some assistance.
7. **Be persistent:** Continue to be persistent with your loved ones in getting them the help they need. Keep in contact with your doctor and any mental health counselor on your progress. If things do not improve, continue to find other alternatives in getting the person some help.




# GIVE THE GIFT OF LIFE

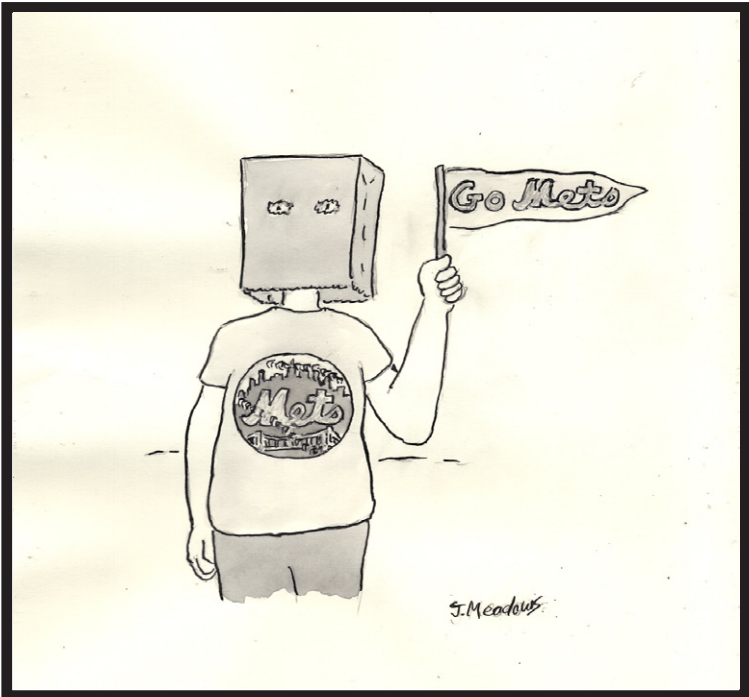
