

This constitutes a **war crime and crime against humanity** as defined by Articles 7 and 8 of the Rome Statute. Furthermore, these operations directly violate international agreements protecting civilian populations, freedom of political expression, and state sovereignty.

I respectfully request:

1. **Immediate investigation and preliminary examination** into the role of these actors.
2. **Protective measures for journalists, whistle blowers, and dissidents** under ICC and UN charters.
3. **Recognition that the United States is currently under technological occupation**, and that these private actors have assumed the functions of war-time sovereigns.

This report is submitted on behalf of the American people and all global civilians affected by the unchecked rise of privatized authoritarian infrastructure. The enclosed documentation is supported by timelines, contracts, data surveillance trails, and cross-verified declarations.

Please confirm receipt and advise on the next steps for tribunal proceedings, evidentiary hearings, or collaborative intelligence briefings.
