

Shooting Event Package

The organizers of any club shooting or instructional event shall ensure the following are in place for the members, guests and public spectators

- Safety Rules of Club
- Safety equipment such as hearing and eye protection
- Certified Range Safety Officers
- Washroom facilities, including toilet paper ets.
- If food is being provided, paper towels, cooking utensils, and proper methods of disposal of garbage etc
- Ensure that the Club cabin or indoor is clean and usable for shelter, meals, & scoring.



Range Rules

- No alcohol on Range
- Use of eye and ear protection is mandatory
- Obey range Operator at all times
- Never approach firing line while anyone is down range
- Always PROVE your firearm SAFE
- Always maintain Safe Muzzle Control
- All handguns require an A.T.T. to enter club property
- All Firearms must meet transporting laws in regards to locks and cases
- Never have your finger in the trigger until ready to fire
- If shooting, always sign the Log-in book
- Always use proper target stands and targets
- No cross firing allowed
- Always leave the Range clean and free of garbage and debris
- All handling and repairs of firearms to be done in Safe Handling Area



RANGE SAEFTY OFFICER

The Range Safety Officer has complete authority on the range property to conduct Organized Shooting Events and Practices.

Range Safety Officers have the responsibility to supervise all personal (shooting and non-shooting alike) present on the property and may have members and/or non members removed at his/her discretion.

All Range Safety Officers operating a facility must have a Valid Range Safety

Officer Certification.
