The Lakewood Pan American Association, once again, will present educational scholarships in various amounts between \$500.00 and \$1,500.00 to Lakewood resident students of high caliber, both in character and academics, who have a strong desire to further their education. The student's enrollment at any accredited college, university or trade school will be acceptable qualification. Since the program's inception there have been 240 proud and deserving recipients of the Lakewood Ambassador Scholarships.

The Scholarship is open to senior students who reside in Lakewood and attend any public or private school. Public service or volunteer achievements are not restricted to Lakewood. Please note that this educational scholarship is not based solely on the highest GPA, but also active citizenship in the community and at school. There are several opportunities to express yourself, including recommendations of others. Recipients must be a Lakewood resident for two (2) years or longer. Proof of residency may be required.

The recipients will also become "Lakewood Ambassadors," and may be asked to participate, if available, in some city functions throughout the year. Applications will be reviewed and all winners will receive written notice of award. Those selected as scholarship recipients will be required to provide a 5x7 photo to be used for publication purposes. These photos will be returned. The awards will be presented, along with recognition, at the El Comienzo Luncheon that will be held at The Centre on Thursday, April 30, 2020. Additionally, award recipients are asked to be available on Saturday, May 9, 2020, at Mayfair Park for the Pan Am Fiesta to be acknowledged by the community for their achievements.

Any falsification of information on this application, or failure to meet all requirements, will lead to disqualification or termination of scholarship. The Pan American Scholarship funds must be used for tuition, books and pre-approved school supplies, or expenses. All money will be held in trust at Farmers & Merchants Bank until proof of registration is provided along with school receipts.

Applications will be reviewed and all recipients of awards will receive written notice. Award recognition and presentation will be held at the El Comienzo Luncheon on Thursday, April 30, 2020, at The Centre. As "Ambassadors" for Lakewood, you may be asked to participate in other Lakewood events.
