Parables

Parables... the Greek word Parabole denotes a placing beside, to throw or lay beside, to compare. It signifies a placing of one thing beside another with a view of comparison. It is the lesson that is of value but the hearer must catch the analogy if he is to be instructed (also true for Proverbs). Such a narrative or saying, dealing with earthly things with spiritual meaning, is distinct from a fable, which attributes to things what does not belong to them in nature. Christ's parables most frequently convey truths connected with the kingdom of God. His withholding the meaning from his hearers as He did from the multitudes was a Divine judgment upon the unworthy.
