

Teach Us to Pray

Prayer is a fundamental part of Christianity and the scriptures give us many examples on what to pray for and in what manner we should and should not pray.

Manner of Prayer: Matt. 6:5-13 Lord's prayer, do not use vain repetitions, pray in secret.

Whole armour of God: Ephesians 6:12-18 Prayer and supplication for saints.

Pray for deliverance: 1Nephi 2:46-50 Dark and dreary waste, tree with fruit to make one happy.

Pray before doing things: 2Nephi 14:9-12 Spirit teaches man to pray, evil spirit teaches them not to.

Pray for your people: 2Nephi 15:2-4 Pray continually, cry unto God in faith, hear my cry.

Console you in your afflictions: Jacob 2:46-50 Pray unto him with exceeding faith.

Wrong way to pray: Alma 18:15-16 Do not pray as Zoramites, seen of men, praise for wisdom.

Sanctification: Helaman 2:29-31 Fast and pray oft, stronger humility, firmer faith.

Avoid Temptations: 3Nephi 8:46-57 Satan desireth you, always pray in my name, pray in families.

Receive Holy Ghost: 3Nephi 9:21-24 Jesus prays for those who believe in the word.

Pray over needs: Alma 16:177-184 Prayer in wilderness, field, house, congregations.

Pray in church: 4Nephi 1:13 Continue in fasting and prayer, meeting together oft, hear word.

Real Intent: Moroni 7:4-8 Do it with real intent, doeth it grudgingly counted as evil.

Receive Charity: Moroni 7:50-53 Pray with all energy of heart, be purified as he is pure.

Pray for others: Enos 1:5-28 Prayed to preserve records, pray for brethren and Lamanites.

Prayer of Repentance: Psalms 38 David prays for forgiveness and deliverance.

Rebuke evil spirits: Matthew 17:16-21 Disciples could not cure, require much fasting and prayer.

House of prayer: Matthew 21:13 Sanctuary to be house of prayer.

Long vain prayers condemned: Matthew 23:14 Pharisees make pretense long prayers, devour widows.

Deliverance from prison: Acts 12:3-16 Church prays for Peter in prison, angel delivers.

Pray over food: 1Timothy 4:3-5 Meats sanctified by word of God and prayer.

Pray for wisdom: James 1:5-8 Ask God, upbraideth not, ask in faith nothing wavering.

Prayers not answered: James 4:1-4 Ask amiss, consume upon lusts.

Pray for sick: James 5:13-20 Effectual fervent prayer availeth much.

Prayers not hindered: 1Peter 3:7 Husbands honour wives lest prayers be hindered.

Prayers not answered: Mosiah 5:48-52 Will not succor in transgression, return with full purpose of heart.
