PURPOSE & PROMISE ANNUAL RAFFLE

Benefiting The M.I.H. Foundation, Inc.

- Sponsor

The Purpose & Promise Annual Raffle (“Raffle”) is sponsored and administered by The M.I.H. Foundation, Inc. (“Foundation”), a Georgia nonprofit organization. Proceeds will support the Foundation’s charitable programs and mission.

- Eligibility

Participants must be at least eighteen (18) years old at the time of entry. The Raffle is void where prohibited or restricted by law.

Members of the Foundation’s Board of Directors, Raffle administrators, and members of their immediate households are [ELIGIBLE / NOT ELIGIBLE] to enter.

- Raffle Tickets

Raffle tickets may be purchased at the following levels:

- \$5 — 1 ticket
- \$25 — 15 tickets
- \$50 — 40 tickets
- \$100 — 100 tickets
- \$200 — 240 tickets
- \$500 — 600 tickets

Each valid ticket represents one entry in the drawing. Ticket purchases are final and non-refundable, except if reimbursement is required by applicable law or the Foundation cancels the Raffle without conducting a drawing.

Raffle tickets are not tax-deductible charitable contributions because the purchaser receives a chance to win a prize.

Tickets may not be transferred or resold without the Foundation’s written authorization. Any ticket obtained through an unauthorized resale, fraudulent transaction, chargeback, or other invalid means may be disqualified.

- Entry Period

Ticket sales begin on August 25, 2026 and end on August October 15, 2027 at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time, or when all available tickets have been sold, whichever occurs first.

The Foundation is not responsible for incomplete, inaccurate, delayed, misdirected, lost, or illegible entries or for payments that cannot be verified.

- Grand Prize

One winner will receive the choice of:

A. One 2019 Forest River Forester recreational vehicle (“RV”); or

B. A cash alternative in the amount of \$50,000.

The winner must make a final, written prize selection within **15** days after receiving official notice from the Foundation. Once made, the winner’s selection is final and cannot be changed.

The prize is nontransferable before it is formally awarded. No substitution is permitted except as expressly stated in these Official Rules or as determined necessary by the Foundation due to circumstances beyond its reasonable control.

- RV Condition

The RV will be awarded in its existing “AS IS, WHERE IS” condition, with all faults and without any express or implied warranty from the Foundation.

The Foundation makes no representation or warranty concerning the RV’s condition, mileage, mechanical systems, appliances, equipment, suitability, merchantability, fitness for a particular

purpose, or future performance. Any manufacturer's warranty that remains valid may be transferred only to the extent permitted by the manufacturer.

The winner is encouraged to inspect the RV before accepting it. Acceptance of the RV constitutes acknowledgment and acceptance of its condition.

- Drawing and Selection of Winner

The winner will be selected at random from all eligible entries received before the entry deadline. The winner does not have to be present unless otherwise announced in writing by the Foundation.

The odds of winning depend on the total number of eligible tickets entered in the drawing.

The Foundation's decisions concerning eligibility, ticket validity, administration of the drawing, and interpretation of these Official Rules are final, subject to applicable law.

- Winner Notification and Verification

The potential winner will be contacted using the telephone number, email address, or other contact information provided at the time of entry.

Before receiving the prize, the potential winner must:

- Provide valid government-issued identification;
- Provide a valid Social Security number or taxpayer identification number;
- Complete IRS Form W-9 and any other required tax documents;
- Sign an affidavit of eligibility, prize acceptance form, liability release, and other reasonably required documents;
- Select either the RV or the stated cash alternative; and
- Pay all amounts that must be collected before the prize can legally be released, including required tax withholding and applicable transfer expenses.

If the potential winner cannot be contacted within 30 days, fails to respond by the stated deadline, is determined to be ineligible, refuses the prize, fails to provide the required documentation or payments, or otherwise fails to comply with these Official Rules, the potential winner may be disqualified and an alternate winner may be selected by random drawing.

- Taxes, Withholding, and Transfer Expenses

The winner is solely responsible for all federal, state, and local income taxes resulting from the prize and for all sales tax, title fees, registration fees, tag fees, transfer fees, insurance costs, transportation expenses, inspection costs, delivery expenses, and any other costs or expenses associated with accepting, transferring, registering, possessing, or using the prize.

The fair market value of the prize may constitute taxable gambling income and may be reported to federal and state taxing authorities as required by law.

If the RV is selected, the winner must pay the Foundation, before delivery or transfer of title, the amount of any federal or state tax withholding that the Foundation is legally required to remit in connection with the noncash prize. The Foundation will not release the RV or transfer its title until all required documents have been completed and all required withholding and transfer amounts have been paid.

If the cash alternative is selected, the Foundation may deduct any legally required tax withholding directly from the cash payment. The amount delivered to the winner may therefore be less than the advertised cash-prize amount.

The winner should consult an independent tax professional regarding the tax consequences of accepting either prize option.

- Transfer and Delivery of RV

The winner must complete the transfer and take possession of the RV within 60 days after being notified that the RV is available.

The winner is responsible for arranging and paying for insurance, registration, transportation, and removal of the RV from its delivery location. Proof of insurance may be required before the RV is released.

If the winner fails to complete the transfer or take possession by the deadline, the Foundation may treat the prize as forfeited and select an alternate winner, subject to applicable law.

The Foundation is not responsible for any loss, damage, maintenance expense, storage expense, accident, injury, or liability arising after the RV has been transferred or released to the winner.

- **Publicity**

Except where prohibited by law, acceptance of the prize authorizes the Foundation to use the winner's name, city and state, photograph, likeness, voice, and prize information for lawful promotional, fundraising, and public-relations purposes without additional compensation.

- **Release of Liability**

To the fullest extent permitted by law, each participant agrees to release and hold harmless The M.I.H. Foundation, Inc., its directors, officers, employees, volunteers, agents, sponsors, service providers, and representatives from claims, losses, damages, injuries, expenses, or liabilities arising from:

- Participation in the Raffle;
- The acceptance, possession, transfer, transportation, use, misuse, or disposition of the prize;
- Mechanical failure or defects involving the RV;
- Incorrect or incomplete participant information; or
- Technical, printing, administrative, or human errors affecting the Raffle.

Nothing in these Official Rules releases any party from liability that cannot legally be waived.

- **Fraud and Disqualification**

The Foundation may reject or disqualify an entry if it reasonably determines that the participant:

- Provided false or misleading information;
 - Attempted to manipulate the drawing or ticketing process;
 - Used an unauthorized payment method;
 - Initiated an improper chargeback;
 - Violated these Official Rules; or
 - Engaged in conduct that threatens the fairness, integrity, or lawful operation of the Raffle.
- **Modification, Suspension, or Cancellation**

The Foundation may modify, suspend, postpone, or cancel the Raffle if fraud, technical failure, legal requirements, government action, natural disaster, or another circumstance beyond its reasonable control prevents the Raffle from being conducted fairly or lawfully.

If the Foundation cancels the Raffle without conducting a drawing, ticket purchases will be handled as required by applicable law and any written cancellation notice issued by the Foundation.

- **Compliance With Law**

The Raffle will be conducted in accordance with applicable federal, state, and local laws and under any license or authorization required by the appropriate governmental authority.

These Official Rules are governed by the laws of the State of Georgia. Any legal proceeding relating to the Raffle must be brought in a court of competent jurisdiction located in **Peach** County, Georgia, unless applicable law requires otherwise.

- **Acceptance of Rules**

By purchasing or accepting a Raffle ticket, each participant acknowledges that they have read, understood, and agreed to these Official Rules.
