

Inkster Housing Commission welcomes you to register as a self-certified Section 3 Resident and become part of a database where Section 3 Workers and Targeted Section 3 Workers may be selected for hiring needs. If you are a recipient of government assistance for housing or if your income falls below HUD's income limits, you may qualify as a Section 3 worker, targeted Section 3 worker, or Section 3 business concern. **Your response is voluntary, confidential, and has no effect on your employment**

The purpose of HUD's Section 3 program is to provide employment, training and contracting opportunities to low-income individuals, particularly those who are recipients of government assistance for housing or other public assistance programs.

Who is a Section 3 Worker?

- A "Section 3 Worker" is a worker who is currently or when hired fit at least one of the following:
 - The worker's income for previous or annualized calendar year is below the income limit established by HUD; or
 - The worker is low- or very low-income.
 - The worker is a YouthBuild participant.
 - YouthBuild is a community-based pre-apprenticeship program that provides job training and educational opportunities for at-risk youth ages 16-24 who have previously dropped out of high school.

Who is a Targeted Section 3 Worker?

- A "Targeted Section 3 Worker" is a worker who is also:
 - Employed by a Section 3 Business Concern
 - A worker who is currently or was when hired by the worker's current employer, as documented within the past 5 years:
 - Resident of public housing or Section 8 recipient
 - Resident of other projects for Section 8 managed by Inkster Housing Commission
 - YouthBuild participant

If you are currently a Public Housing Resident or a Housing Choice Voucher Program Participant, you are a Targeted Section 3 Worker.
