# Security

Two security cameras look at the driveway and side gate for your security and front door entry camera. A safe is provided for guest use in the 2nd bedroom.

There is a smart TV in the Living Area and the Primary Bedroom with streaming services like Netflix and Amazon Prime Video. Please feel free to log in to your own accounts and enjoy your favorite shows. Don't forget to log out again before you leave!

# Working out / Peloton

If you have a Peloton account you are welcome to use our bike, you will just need to bring your cycling cleats with you. Alternatively, you can sign in to take one of the Strength or yoga classes. We have a matted area and some free weights in the garage.





# House Rules

We want you to have an amazing relaxing stay and to enjoy yourselves. Here is the boring legal stuff we must say, and please remember this is our home. Kindly respect our home and the neighborhood. We kindly request you observe:

- § Please respect the check-in and check-out time.
- § Please do not share the access code with unregistered guests.
- § No parties or large gatherings allowed.
- § Please keep noise to a minimum between 10:00 pm and 10:00 am.
- § No illegal substances or activities allowed.
- § No smoking in the house or grounds.
- § Please be careful not to damage the furnishings or ornaments, let us know if anything is inadvertently damaged during your stay.
- § Please close windows and lock the sliding doors securely behind you when you're not in.
- § Please turn off the air conditioning when you go out.
- § Do not leave the pool umbrellas up when not in use. Wind can cause them to blow over and break and you will be responsible for the \$150 replacement fee

The City of Palm Springs municipal ordinance prohibits any music outside or even inside that can be heard outside. Occupants are subject to citation and \$500 fine. No more than 3 cars are permitted at any time even if someone is just dropping something off so plan accordingly. A maximum of 6 adult guests are permitted at a 3-bedroom house.





# Heating / Cooling

A nest thermostat to control the heating and cooling can be found in the hall. Nest thermostats don't have a touch screen.to use it, just turn the ring up when you want it a little warmer, and turn it down when you want it a little cooler.

The primary bedroom and the main guest room have additional mini spits controlled via a remote.

The small guest room has a wall operated fan (Please note 1 is the max setting and 4 is the low)

Please ensure windows and doors are closed with the air is in use. If you're not at the home, please turn off all the A/C units when leaving.

# Bathrooms

Each bathroom has a rain head shower with a handheld wand. There is a bidet WC with flush / control knob to the side – alternatively you can wave your foot at the sensor in front to flash.

# Lighting

All the outdoor lights are on dusk till dawn timers. The ambient lighting in the main living area are programmed to be on between dusk till midnight.





Pool

NO DIVING & NO GLASS OUTSIDE. All guests swim in the pool at their own risk. You are liable for any incident or injury. Please use only the Acrylic / Plastic cups and dishware outside. Pool towels can be found next to the patio doors

Our pool is fully automated, please do not try to amend the settings. Pool heating must be confirmed prior to your stay and we will programme the heating for your arrival.

A \$100 daily pool heating charge (actual energy costs) and if added must be ordered for the length of your stay as it takes one day to come up to temperature and we turn it on before your arrival.

Pool toys and floats are kept in the storage trunk to by the pool.

Pool maintenance takes place 2 x a week usually a Wednesday and Saturday. Jeronimo our trusted pool person will not disturb you. After his service, please wait 2 hours before using the pool.

Landscaping Maintenance
The landscaper comes on a Saturday mornings.



# Hot Tub





Please ensure you have confirmed usage prior to your stay to ensure the Hot Tub has been prepared for your arrival. Please unclip all the cover clips at the front and bac before attempting to pull off the cover. The set temperature range is from 80°F to 104°F (26°C to 40°C). The recommended temp is 100°.

The JETS hard button activates the jet pumps. When the JETS hard button is pressed, the jets menu will be displayed on the control panel with Jet 1 in the Low position, the Jet Pump icon will also display on the home screen. Press any of the soft keys to change the jet functions between high or low.

# Fire Pit


To usethe fire pit, first the valve at the side of the house next to the gas meter must be turned on.

Then the key by the firepit needs to be used to turn the fire pit on before lighting (a safety lighter can be found in the kitchen drawer). Once finished please be sure to turn off the gas at the Fire Pit and the valve at the side of the house (to a horizontal position to stop the flow).


Location of Gas Meter



Move the yellow valve to a down position to allow gas to flow to the fire pit.



Then the key by the firepit needs to be used to turn the fire pit on before lighting (a safety lighter can be found in the kitchen drawer).



Please exercise caution when using. A fire extinguisher can be found in the garage to your right as you enter and also in the Kitchen.



# Departure

Check out is prior to 10am. If you would like to request a late checkout for an additional fee, please reach out. We do our best to accommodate late check-outs when we can.

Before you leave, please remember:

- § Check each room for personal belongings.
- § Please turn off all AC Units
- § Check refrigerator for personal food items.
- § Check washer dryer for any items.
- § Please close all doors and windows.

# Laundry

The washer and dryer can be found in the garage. Please use them as you need, laundry pods can be found in the closet in the garage. Use them by tossing the pod into the drum of the washer per cycle. We recommend checking the lint tap in the dryer between uses to ensure the drying cycle is not interrupted.

Trash / Recycling Collection / Cleaning Supplies
Recycling and trash are collected on Thursdays. We kindly ask
the correct receptacles at the side of the house are utilized.
Basic cleaning supplies can be found under the sink and a
vacuum can be found in the HVAC closet in the hall.





#### Palm Springs Guidelines for Vacation Rentals

By the City of Palm Springs Ordinance, the following is required to rent a short-term rental (less than 28 days) in the city:

- 1. Primary renter must be at least 25 years of age.
- 2. Primary renter must provide a copy of his/her government-issued I.D. before check-in. A copy of the I.D. is kept on file while the guest is at the property and will be shared with Vacation Rental Compliance Officials on demand as required by law.
- 3. Responsible party (primary renter) is required to sign a short-term rental agreement (contract).
- 4. All guests are required to print and sign names to the City of Palm Springs confirmation that the Good Neighbor Brochure has been read and understood by all adult occupants (this will be emailed with the rental agreement).
- 5. No more than 2 adults or children per bedroom (6 max) are allowed to occupy the home overnight with 2 additional guests allowed during daytime hours.
- 6. No more than 1 car per bedroom is allowed to be parked at the house overnight with 1 additional car allowed during daytime hours (3 cars max)
- 7. Trash must be kept in the provided receptacle out of public view.
- 8. Dogs are to be kept on a leash at all times when not in the home or in the confined space of the property. Dogs are to be kept from barking. A consistently barking dog is considered a nuisance.
- 9. Outdoor music is prohibited 24 hours per day. It is further expected that noise created at the home will not be audible beyond the property line. Quiet time is between 8pm and 8am.

\*\*These rules are set forth by the City Ordinance and apply to ALL rentals in the City of Palm Springs. They are intended to help create peaceful neighborhoods in which rentals exist.

# Palm Springs Art Museum


