## Southern Stryker Gun Dogs Go Home Contract

I have looked over my dog's health and agree my dog is going home from Southern Stryker Gun Dog's Kennel in the following condition:

- I understand that my dog has been exercised and trained regularly. But I agree that my dog is going home in a good condition (could be slightly thinner than when arrived) but my dog is not severely underweight with his/her spine protruding nor hip bones protruding.
- I understand that by my dog staying in a concrete kennel, it could have some slight "concrete rubs" and small patches of hair missing. But I agree that my dog is not going home with a large number of missing patches of hair.
- I have looked over my dog and he/she does not appear to be limping.
- I have looked over my dog and there are no large visible cuts.
- To my knowledge, my dog is in good health and condition.
- If my dog was injured at all during the stay, I was informed immediately and Southern Stryker Gun Dogs handled it in a professional manner. Where I was given the option to have my dog brought to the vet or hold off for up to 48 hours.
- If my dog needed veterinary care, Southern Stryker Gun Dogs brought my dog to the vet and I
  was informed of my dog's condition as I was presented the invoice immediately from leaving the
  vet's office.
- I understand that by my dog going back to a "home" setting, they may be stressed out a bit and have diarrhea for the first 24-48 hours.
- I understand that even though my dog was kept up with current preventatives, that by being a kennel setting my could still return home with fleas/ ticks, heartworms or intestinal parasites. And if they do, Southern Stryker Gun Dogs are NOT responsible for treatment.
- I understand that if there are any reasons to believe that my dog was ill or injured from the Southern Stryker Gun Dogs facility, they would be brought to the vet within 24 hours of going home. And by waiting past the 24 hour window, I released Southern Stryker Gun Dogs responsible as I cannot prove that the dog did not get sick or injured in my care.
