DAY 4

28th November – Train Journey -Arrival & Transfer to Gangtok

Take the Vande Bharat Train from Howrah Station (world's biggest and busiest train station) to New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP). The 8 hours train journey takes you through scenic rice fields of Bengal.

Upon arrival at New Jalpaiguri Railway Station (NJP) begin your picturesque journey towards Gangtok, the beautiful capital city of Sikkim, surrounded by lush green hills, mountain rivers, and scenic Himalayan landscapes. During the drive, guests can enjoy mesmerizing views of the Teesta River flowing alongside the winding mountain roads.

The journey to Gangtok takes approximately 4.5 to 5.5 hours depending on road and weather conditions.

After reaching Gangtok, check in to the premium 4-star deluxe hotel and relax after the long journey. In the evening, tourists may explore the nearby local market or MG Marg on their own for shopping, cafés, and local experiences.

DAY 5

29th November – Excursion to Nathula Pass, Baba Mandir & Tsomgo Lake

The route offers breathtaking mountain scenery, snow-covered landscapes (seasonal), winding roads, and pristine alpine beauty.

Sightseeing Covered:

1. Tsomgo Lake (Changu Lake)

A sacred glacial lake situated at an altitude of 12,400 ft, surrounded by rugged mountains and changing seasonal colors. Guests may enjoy yak rides and photography around the lake area.

2. Baba Harbhajan Singh Mandir

A famous shrine dedicated to Baba Harbhajan Singh, an Indian Army soldier believed to spiritually protect the border region.

3. Nathula Pass

One of the highest motorable roads in the world and an important Indo-China border post. Guests can experience panoramic Himalayan views and feel the thrilling high-altitude atmosphere.

After sightseeing, return to Gangtok by evening.

- Nathula Pass visit is subject to permit approval and weather conditions.
- In case Nathula remains closed due to landslide, snowfall, or government restrictions, alternate sightseeing will be arranged.

30th November – Full Day Gangtok Local Sightseeing

1. Banjhakri Waterfalls

3. Ganesh Tok

A small hilltop temple dedicated to Lord Ganesha offering panoramic views of Gangtok town and surrounding mountains.

4. Hanuman Tok

5. Tashi View Point

7. Bakthang Waterfalls

A scenic roadside waterfall ideal for photography and enjoying the fresh mountain atmosphere.

2. Temi Tea Garden

Sikkim's only tea estate, known for its sprawling tea plantations and breathtaking mountain backdrop.

Continue the scenic drive towards Darjeeling, popularly known as the "Queen of Hills."

Upon arrival, check in to the premium hotel and relax.

4. Batasia Loop

A unique spiral railway loop with beautifully maintained gardens and war memorial.

5. Ghum Monastery

One of the oldest Tibetan Buddhist monasteries in Darjeeling.

6. Tenzing & Gombu Rock

Popular rock climbing training spot named after legendary mountaineers.

7. Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park

Famous for conservation of rare Himalayan wildlife including Red Panda and Snow Leopard.

8. Chitrey Tea Garden

Experience the beauty of lush tea estates and Himalayan tea culture.

9. Tibetan Refugee Self Help Centre

A cultural center preserving Tibetan handicrafts and traditions.

10. Darjeeling Ropeway

Enjoy breathtaking aerial views of valleys, tea gardens, and mountains.

Return to hotel by evening.

DAY 9

03 December – Excursion to Lamahatta & Tinchuley

One of the most picturesque tea gardens in the Darjeeling hills.

4. Mirik Lake

Enjoy boating and lakeside walks surrounded by pine forests and mountain views.

5. Lepchajagat Pine Forest

A serene forest area famous for peaceful atmosphere and bird watching.

Sudhanyakhali Watch Tower In this Tiger Reserve area for our share of viewing animals like deer, crocodile, wild boar, snakes, water monitor lizard, different types of birds and also Royal Bengal Tiger (if you are lucky).

12.30 AM: Visit Do-Banki Tiger Reserve Area & Watch Tower. The 896 meter canopy walk at Do Banki gives you an opportunity to view wildlife from enclosure.

01.30 PM: A Visit to Panchamukhni 5 River junction, Tiger Reserve Area & Watch Tower through Boat.
