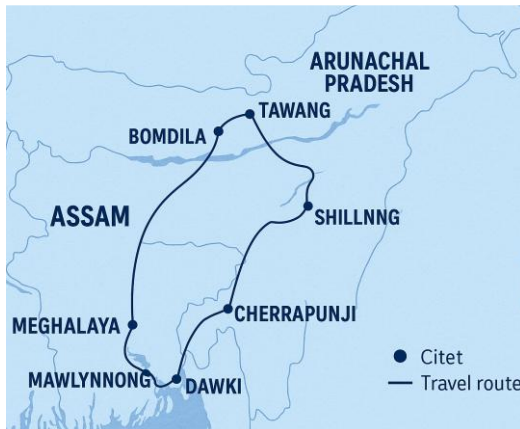

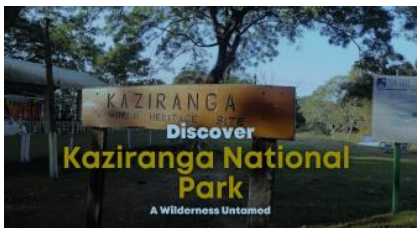
DAY 05 - Guwahati to Kaziranga (204 km / 4.5 hrs) | Meal - Dinner

Arrive at Railway Station. Begin your drive toward the Kaziranga National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site famous for being the natural habitat of the endangered one-horned rhinoceros. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and relax. Overnight Stay: Kaziranga. The park's diverse landscape includes dense forests, tall elephant grass, marshlands, and numerous water bodies. In addition to rhinos, Kaziranga is home to a significant population of tigers, elephants, wild water buffalo, and swamp deer, making it one of the most biologically diverse parks in India.

Sightseeing Highlights:

Evening visit to Orchid & Biodiversity Park

Optional cultural performance in the evening



DAY 06: Kaziranga Safari | Meal- Breakfast & Dinner

Early morning: Enjoy an exciting Elephant Safari in the park. (subject to operation and availability). Explore the rich wildlife and natural beauty of this iconic park, known for its one-horned rhinoceroses, tigers, elephants, and a wide variety of birdlife.

Return to the hotel for breakfast and rest. (entry & activities on a direct payment basis). The park features a rich collection of orchids, medicinal plants, bamboo species, and local tribal culture through museums and traditional performances.

In the afternoon enjoy jeep safari through the National Park Explore exotic wildlife including one-horned rhinos, royal Bengal tigers, hog deer, and wild elephants. Evening at leisure. Overnight stay in Kaziranga.

Important Note: Elephant rides are all regulated and controlled by the forest Dept. Govt. of Assam. We do not have any control over the booking. Elephant ride & Jeep safari are subject to availability only.

DAY 07: Kaziranga to Bomdila-(230 km / 7 hrs) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

Post breakfast, depart for Bomdila a picturesque town nestled in the Eastern Himalayas. The drive takes you through lush tea gardens, river valleys, and tribal villages, offering a beautiful introduction to Arunachal Pradesh. Overnight Stay: Bomdila

DAY 08: Bomdila to Tawang (180 km / 7 hrs) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

Embark on one of the most beautiful Himalayan journeys as you drive to Tawang. The winding mountain roads lead you through snow-capped landscapes and strategic mountain passes. Overnight Stay: Tawang

DAY 09: Local Sightseeing in Tawang | Meals- Breakfast

Spend the day exploring Tawang, a spiritually and culturally rich destination. Overnight Stay: Tawang

DAY 10: Tawang - Bumla Pass (37 km) - Madhuri Lake - (only Indian) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, proceed for a full-day excursion to Bumla Pass (subject to permits and weather conditions), located about 37 km from Tawang at an altitude of 16,000 ft near the Indo-China border. A visit to Bumla is a thrilling experience for adventure lovers, offering a rare opportunity to witness the border area guarded by Indian Army personnel.

On the return journey, visit Pankang Teng Tso Lake (PT Tso) at 12,000 ft a serene high-altitude lake surrounded by pine forests and seasonal snow.

Continue to Shonga-tser Lake, famously known as Madhuri Lake, named after the Bollywood actress Madhuri Dixit, who shot a song here for the film Koyla. The lake was formed after a 1971 earthquake transformed the once grassy meadow into this beautiful water body, surrounded by dramatic landscapes and snow-clad mountains.

Return to Tawang by evening. Later, witness the Light & Sound Show at the Tawang War Memorial (tickets at own cost), which beautifully narrates the valor of Indian soldiers during the 1962 Indo-China war. Overnight Stay at Tawang

DAY 11: Tawang to Dirang (140 km / 4.5 hrs) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, check out and travel back through the hills to the scenic valley of Dirang. En route enjoy spectacular landscapes, quaint villages, and cultural sites. Overnight Stay: Dirang

TDL Monastery

Dirang is also famous for hot water springs where people take bath to cure skin ailments



DAY 12: Dirang to Guwahati (300 km / 10 hrs) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

Start early and proceed back to Guwahati, a long yet scenic drive through changing topography. This journey through Kalaktang is filled with lush valleys, farms, and fresh mountain air. Upon Arrival At The Hotel Check In And Relax. Overnight Stay At Guwahati.

DAY 13: Guwahati to Cherrapunji (150 km / 4 hrs) | Breakfast & Dinner

After breakfast, continue to Cherrapunji (locally known as Sohra), which holds the title of one of the wettest places on Earth. Overnight Stay: Cherrapunji

Standard accommodations over there are available; just with clean rooms, hygienic bathroom & basic non vegetarian food (very limited options are there for vegetarian guests).

DAY 14: Cherrapunji - Mawlynnong (81 km / 2.5 hrs) - Dawki (31 km / 1.5 hrs) - Shillong (79 km / 3 hrs) | Meals- Breakfast & Dinner

Itinerary can be shuffle depending on the room availability, weather condition, political issue

Carrier on vehicles not available in Assam, Meghalaya & Arunachal.

Permit required for Arunachal Pradesh (ILP). It is mandatory that guests should carry 02 copies of passport size photograph, original photo ID proof with photo copy Passport for processing the permit. PAN Card is not acceptable for issuance of the Permit.

Permit is also required for traveling to Bumla Pass. Requires 02 more copies of passport size photographs along with original photo ID proof

Elephant safari at Kaziranga entirely depends on the sole discretion of the Park Authority not on Guaranteed basis and also depending upon the weather/flood condition, even if the park remains open, and subject to availability only

If you get a chance to go for Elephant Safari at Central (Kohora) range you have to pay Rs.1000 per Forest Vehicle directly for pick up and drop from the hotel as outside vehicles are not allowed to go to riding point (Central range) due to no-horn zone.

Due to remote location and limited options in Cherrapunjee and Arunachal sector we use properties as per their service. Mostly properties are not categorised as 3/4*. One cannot compare the properties with that of Shillong / Guwahati.

We are not responsible if any sightseeing point missed out due to any delay of guest or any unforced incident like road blockage, heavy rainfall, snow fall, landslide or earlier darkness.

In any tourist place, vehicle accessibility is typically limited to certain points, and this can vary from place to place.

Safari is totally under Govt of Assam rules & regulations

Drivers do not speak English and are not in uniform. They can only communicate in Hindi or local languages. We kindly ask for your cooperation with them during your journey

Entry Formalities Foreigners:

Assam: No entry permits are required for Indians or Foreigners

Meghalaya: No entry permits are required for Indians or Foreigners

Arunachal Pradesh: Domestic Indian tourists need an Inner Line Permit or ILP. This is available from any Government of Arunachal Pradesh office or from the Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs and New Delhi.

Foreign tourists may visit in a group of two or more persons for a stay not to exceed 30 days.

Standard accommodations over there are available; just with clean rooms, hygienic bathroom & basic non vegetarian food (very limited options are there for vegetarian guests). It is advisable for the guests seeking luxury and comfort, should visit Sohra (Cherrapunjee) & Dawki as a day excursion by extending their overnight stay at Shillong.

About Hotel in Arunachal:

Hotels available are only with basic amenities & simple food. This region is a paradise for non-vegetarians, and limited options are available for vegetarian guests. There are no star hotels in the Arunachal region. The facilities available cannot be matched with the other developed destinations. The region's prime tourist interest is its nature and eco-friendly atmosphere. Please be informed that this region can be enjoyed in its natural beauty and simple flavor.

Notes:

All hotels do not have lift facilities & the guest may have to climb stairs. For specific requirements, please inform us and we will try to provide. This is again subject to availability. For CP, MAP and AP meal plans, the menu will be fixed and not on A-la-Carta basis. For early morning check out breakfast may be limited or not available.

In the region, scarcity of water & electricity is a natural phenomenon. Guests are requested to bear with such problems as may arise during the tour.

The altitude of Tawang (Arunachal Pradesh) is more than 10000 feet and it is cold throughout the year. The medical facilities are also limited. Hence we do not recommend guests with medical conditions like heart ailment, blood pressure, back pain, lung ailment, COPD to travel to these places. These places are also not recommended for infants.

Check-in and Check-out time as per Hotel policy, Generally check-in time at the hotel is 2:00 PM & check-out time is 11:00 Am.

Important Facts for Travellers :

It is advisable to carry sufficient cash during your trip, as online payment options or card facilities may not be available in all locations, especially in remote or rural areas. This ensures you have a hassle-free experience for transactions like shopping, dining, or other activities where digital payments are not accepted.

The guest should always keep cool with the drivers as they are not tourism educated and come from different remote villages.

The tourism infrastructure in Seven Sister is not very developed and one should not expect or compare it with the standards of plains & other developed destinations. There is always scarcity of water and power in the region and so you would come across situations like water (hot) being supplied on time basis morning & evening.

As there is shortage of space for car parking in the entire Seven Sister region, guests may have to wait at the Lobby in time for the vehicle to start their sightseeing/transfers.

Please inform your guest to maintain the timing for the sightseeing / transfers which will be advisable by our executive.

Room Heater available with an extra cost borne by the guest directly (Except at Premium & Luxury Packages).

Due to shortage of power the guest sometimes may have to bear it with candle light.

Basic personal items to be carried include, feather jacket & heavy woolens during winter and light woolens during summer, walking boots, Umbrella or rain proof jacket during monsoon, spare batteries, water flask, cold cream, personal medicines & Sunglasses.
