

## Winter 2025 Consumer Product Safety Commission Recalls

**Name of Product:** Anna Queen Play Yards

**Play Yards Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Suffocation and Entrapment Hazards; Violate Mandatory Standard for Play Yards; Sold on Amazon by Anna Queen**

**Hazard:** The play yards violate the mandatory standard for [play yards](#). Infants can become entrapped under the mattress or between the side of the play yard and the mattress, posing a risk of serious injury or deadly suffocation hazard.

**Name of Product:** Bearlala Baby Loungers

**Bearlala Baby Loungers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment and Fall Hazards; Violates Mandatory Standard for Infant Sleep Products; Sold on Walmart.com by Nuoxuann**

**Hazard:** The recalled baby loungers violate the mandatory standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#). The sides are too low to contain an infant. The enclosed openings at the foot of the loungers are wider than allowed, posing fall and entrapment hazards to infants. In addition, the baby loungers do not have a stand, posing a fall hazard, if used on elevated surfaces. These violations create an unsafe sleeping environment and can cause death or serious injury to infants.

**Name of Product:** Vevor Baby Swings

**Hazard:** The swings were marketed for infant sleep and have an incline angle greater than 10 degrees, violating the mandatory safety standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#) and the ban on inclined sleepers under the [Safe Sleep for Babies Act](#), posing a deadly suffocation risk.

**Name of Product:** Napei Collapsible Infant Bath Tubs

**Napei Infant Bath Tubs Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Ingestion Hazard; Violates Mandatory Standard for Consumer Products with Button Cell Batteries; Sold on Amazon by Sefon Store**

**Hazard:** The recalled infant bath tubs violate the mandatory standard for consumer products containing button cell or coin batteries because the built-in thermometer contains button cell batteries that can be accessed easily by children. When button cell or coin batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns and death.

**Name of Product:** Vevor Baby Swings

**Sanven Technology Recalls Vevor Baby Swings Due to Risk of Serious Injury from Suffocation Hazard; Violates Mandatory Standard for Infant Sleep Products and Inclined Sleepers Ban**

**Hazard:** The swings were marketed for infant sleep and have an incline angle greater than 10 degrees, violating the mandatory safety standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#) and the ban on inclined sleepers under the [Safe Sleep for Babies Act](#), posing a deadly suffocation risk.

**Name of Product:** 5-in-1 Convertible High Chairs

**5-in-1 Convertible High Chairs Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Fall and Entrapment Hazards; Violates Mandatory Standard for High Chairs; Imported by Harppa**

**Hazard:** The high chairs pose a risk of serious injury or death to children because they violate the mandatory standard for high chairs. The high chairs were sold without the required attached restraint system, posing a serious risk of falls to children. In addition, a child's head can become trapped in the opening created between the seat and the tray, posing a deadly entrapment hazard.

**Name of Product:** Pack-N-Stroll Utility Wagons

**Olympia Tools International Recalls Pack-N-Stroll Utility Wagons Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment and Falls; Violates Mandatory Standard for Strollers**

**Hazard:** The utility wagon violates the mandatory standard for [strollers](#) because an opening between the organizational tray and the sidewall may cause a child's head to become entrapped, posing a risk of serious injury or death. In addition, the utility wagon's lack of a restraint system poses a risk of falls to children.

**Name of Product:** Belivium Baby Loungers

**Belivium Baby Loungers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Suffocation and Entrapment Hazards; Violates Mandatory Standard for Infant Sleep Products; Sold on Amazon by Belivium**

**Hazard:** The baby loungers violate the mandatory standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#) because the sides are shorter than the minimum side height limit to secure the infant; the sleeping pad's thickness exceeds the maximum limit, posing a suffocation hazard; and the enclosed openings at the foot of the loungers are wider than allowed, posing fall and entrapment hazards to infants. The portable loungers do not have a stand, posing a fall hazard. These violations create an unsafe sleeping environment for infants, posing a risk of serious injury or death.

**Name of Product:** YGJT Baby Loungers

**YGJT Baby Loungers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment and Fall; Violates Mandatory Standard for Infant Sleep Products; Sold on SHEIN by YGJT Local Warehouse**

**Hazard:** The recalled baby loungers violate the mandatory standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#). The sides are too low to contain an infant. The enclosed openings at the foot of the loungers are wider than allowed, posing a fall and an entrapment hazard to infants. In addition, the baby loungers do not have a stand, posing a fall hazard, if used on elevated surfaces. These violations create an unsafe sleeping environment for infants and can cause death or serious injury to infants.

**Name of Product:** Mom Genius Retractable Safety Gates

**Mom Genius Recalls Retractable Safety Gates Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Entrapment; Violates Mandatory Standard for Gates and Enclosures**

**Hazard:** The recalled gates violate the mandatory standard for expansion gates and expandable enclosures because a child's torso can fit through the opening between the gate and the floor, posing a risk of serious injury or death due to entrapment.

**Name of Product:** URMWYO Baby Loungers

**URMWYO Baby Loungers Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Suffocation and Fall Hazard; Violates Mandatory Standard for Infant Sleep Products; Sold on Amazon by Pomona**

**Hazard:** The baby loungers violate the mandatory standard for [Infant Sleep Products](#) because the sides are shorter than the minimum side height limit to secure the infant; the sleeping pad's thickness exceeds the maximum limit, posing a suffocation hazard; and an infant could fall out of an enclosed opening at the foot of the lounger or become entrapped. The portable loungers do not have a stand, posing a fall hazard. These violations create an unsafe sleeping environment for infants, posing a risk of serious injury or death.

**Name of Product:** Youbeien Crib Mobiles

**Youbeien Crib Mobiles Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Battery Ingestion; Violates the Mandatory Toy Standard for Batteries; Sold on Amazon by GKKBSJ**

**Hazard:** The recalled toys violate the mandatory standard for toys containing button batteries because the compartment that holds the batteries in the remote can be accessed without the use of a common household tool. If button cell or coin batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, including internal chemical burns and death.

**Name of Product:** AliExpress Convertible Strollers

**AliExpress Recalls Convertible Strollers Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Fall Hazard; Violates Mandatory Standard for Strollers**

**Hazard:** The stroller violates the mandatory standard for [strollers](#) because the restraint system can fail, posing a risk of serious injury or deadly fall hazard.

**Name of Product:** Zippee Silicone Activity Toys

**Zippee Silicone Activity Toys Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Choking; Violates Mandatory Standard for Toys; Imported by Mobi Games**

**Hazard:** The recalled silicone activity toys contain spherical ends that can reach the back of the throat, posing a serious choking hazard to children.

**Name of Product:** Bettina Doll Sets

**Bettina Doll Sets Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Battery Ingestion; Violates Mandatory Standard for Toys; Sold on Amazon by Shantou Chenghai Xingzigu Toy Industry**

**Hazard:** The doll sets violate the mandatory standard for toys because the battery compartment of the unicorn contains button cell batteries that can be easily accessed by children. When button cell or coin batteries are swallowed, the ingested batteries can cause serious injuries, internal chemical burns and death.

**Name of Product:** Ritons Generic Magnetic Ball Sets

**Generic Magnetic Ball Sets Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Magnet Ingestion; Violates Mandatory Standard for Toys; Sold on Amazon by Ritons**

**Hazard:** The recalled 3 mm magnetic ball sets violate the mandatory standard for toys because the magnet sets contain loose magnets posing an ingestion hazard to children. When high-powered magnets are swallowed, the ingested magnets can attract each other, or other metal objects, and become lodged in the digestive system. This can result in perforations, twisting, and/or blockage of the intestines, blood poisoning and death.

**Name of Product:** Shierdu Children's Toys

**Shierdu Children's Toys Recalled Due to Risk of Serious Injury or Death from Choking Hazard;  
Violates the Small Parts Ban; Sold on Amazon by Yiwu Shiyi Trading**

**Hazard:** The recalled toy is intended for children under three years of age and contains small parts, which violates the small parts ban, posing a deadly choking hazard.
