

Are You Walking Circumspectly

- Strong's Hebrew H8104 שָׁמַר shâmar, shaw-mar'; a primitive root; properly, to hedge about (as with thorns), i.e. guard; generally, to protect, attend to, etc.:—beward, be **circumspect**, take heed (to self), keep(-er, self), mark, look narrowly, observe, preserve, regard, reserve, save (self), sure, (that lay) wait (for), watch(-man).
 - CIRCUMSPECT, adjective Literally, looking on all sides; looking round. Hence, Cautious; prudent; watchful on all sides; examining carefully all the circumstances that may affect a determination, or a measure to be adopted. (Webster 1828)
 - Definition of circumspect: careful to consider all circumstances and possible consequences. "Circumspect." *Merriam-Webster.com Dictionary, Merriam-Webster*, <https://www.merriam-webster.com/dictionary/circumspect>. Accessed 30 Apr. 2020.
 - Wary and unwilling to take risks. (Google)
 - Essentially don't risk the biscuit.
1. Exodus 23:12-13 (Keep Sabbath; In all things that Yah has instructed us in we must not be willing to risk being wrong [Circumspect]. We are to be extremists In this verse it refers to speaking the names of other gods. So we should not risk eternal life by saying the Babylon names of the days, months, or cereal. This applies to all of his commands in the instruction manual. Don't risk over a pork chop, keeping sabbath, divorce, lying, etc... Do not be like those who say things like "I don't think God cares what I eat." "I think God wants me to be happy and my wife/husband does not make me happy so I do not think God minds if I get divorce." Circumspectly means do not risk it. If you are not 100% sure then stray on the side of caution.)
 2. Ephesians 5:1-15
 - Verse 1=Approach God as a child with a parent. Fear him, honor him, respect him, & do what he says.
 - Verse 2=Jesus crucifixion ended the Sacrificial law not the Royal law. In the proceeding verses Paul instructs the gentiles at Ephesus to keep the Royal Law.
 - Verses 6-7=Vain words: Let no man lie to you about keeping the law/commandments and cause you to get tossed in the Lake of Fire. This can be a Sunday pastor, family, friends, atheists, other religionists, etc.. You must cut these types of people out of your life.
 - Verses 8-17=Once in the truth of Yah's word we are not to do those things that transgressed his law as we did before. We are to also use the bible to prove those things which are acceptable to the Lord. So if they cannot read it out of the Bible then it is not acceptable to the Lord. It is vain and man's traditions. Those that we socialize with outside of commerce I.E. family and friends should be commandment keepers as well. If they are not when you are around them you are to reprove them. When you reprove them you are shining light on their darkness.
 3. 1 Corinthians 5:9-11 (Remove lawbreakers from your social circle.)
 4. Joshua 22:5 (Your walk with Yah must be circumspect. Paying attention to keep every detail so as not to risk the biscuit.)

5. Joshua 23:11-16 (For the church today put this passage in a spiritual context)
 - Verse 11=Be circumspect that you love God. See Nehemiah 1:5 & John 14:15_21
 - Verses 12-13=Once in the truth you cannot go back to your old way of life. Once you are baptized and in covenant with Yah there is no turning back. If you do turn back to those things he will punish you. Things you used to do and suffered no consequences will now have them for example before you were in the truth you were a fornicator. In the truth you return to fornicating again and you catch a std. You go back committing fraud and this time get arrested.
 - Verses 15-16=Just like we expect God to keep all of his good promises; he will keep all of the bad ones as well.
6. 1 Timothy 4:12-16
 - Verse 12=Do not get down trodden because your momma, daddy, big momma, uncles, aunts, former pork chop pastor say to you "How can you teach us God's word? I was reading the Bible before you were born." Maybe they were that does not make them any less wrong. If you got to college to be a mathematician; just because your momma who barely passed high school was doing math before you were born, doesn't not mean she knows more. We are to be examples even in our youth and walk circumspectly. See John 9:18-34, Luke 2:40-52, & 1 Samuel 3
 - Verse 13=Be circumspect in reading:Read your Bible constantly, exhortation:Telling others to keep Yah's commandments, & doctrine:Rightly divide the word of truth, study to show thyself approved, the Bible is not for private interpretation.
 - Verse 14=Neglect not wy you were baptized
 - Verse 15-16=Think on Yah's word and be circumspect to thyself and his word so you can save yourself and those that hear you
