- I.* Ashera(h) = "groves (for idol worship)"
 - A.* a Babylonian (Astarte)-Canaanite goddess (of fortune and happiness), the supposed consort of Baal, her images
 - i.* the goddess, goddesses
 - ii.* her images
 - iii.* sacred trees or poles set up near an altar

Strong's Definitions (Strong's Definitions Legend)

אֲשֵׁרָה 'ăshêrâh, ash-ay-raw'; or אֲשֵׁי־רָה 'ăshêyrâh; from [H833](#); happy; Asherah (or Astarte) a Phoenician goddess; also an image of the same:—grove. Compare [H6253](#).
