

Keeping Elohim's Law: Holy Days (High Sabbaths & Feasts)

- In the Old and New Testament Elohim's Holy Days are referred to as Feast Days and Sabbaths/High.
- We are to observe the Holy Days of the Most High & not the holydays/holidays or holydays of man. These customs are based in idolatry and paganism; which make them off limits to followers of Christ. See: Exodus 20:1-11 (You are serving other gods when you ignore Elohim's Feast Days and observe other days like Christmas, Easter, New Year, etc...), Jeremiah 10:1-5 (Christmas tree examples), Deuteronomy 16:20-22 (Land to inherit=New Jerusalem the mother of us all and the real land the patriarchs sought after. Observing demonic man made holidays will not get you into the land but instead the lake of fire. Making it into that land is the main point of all the Feast Days/High Sabbaths), Hebrews 11:8-10, Galatians 4:26, 2 Corinthians 6:14-18 (Flee from idolatry) Galatians 4:8-11
- holiday (n.) 1500s, earlier haliday (c. 1200), from Old English haligdæg "holy day, consecrated day, religious anniversary; Sabbath," from halig "holy" (see holy) + dæg "day" (see day); in 14c. meaning both "religious festival" and "day of exemption from labor and recreation," but pronunciation and sense diverged 16c. (Whose Holy Days are you observing?)
- The Lord's Feast Days all point to Elohim's (GodHead=Father & Son, God & Word, Jesus & Jehovah, Jehovah & Jehovah, etc...) plan for mankind. Pointing to the two Kingdoms. First the Son's Kingdom and then the Father's. See Ephesians 5:5

1. Leviticus 23:1-5 (Are these the Jews feasts or the Most High's? The Sabbath points to Jesus' rest which will be his thousand year reign of peace after he punished the world with massive killing and destruction during the tribulation and at this second coming.)
2. Hebrews 3:6-19

4. Isaiah 11:1-12



5. Exodus 12:1-9_12-14 (This day represents Jesus dying for our sins and passing over them. This is why Christ was crucified on Passover. Passover is celebrated at Sundown on the 14th day of the first month which is Abib. By faith the Israelites and mixed multitude put the blood of the lamb on the doorpost and by faith we must come to Christ and his grace. The Lamb being perfect represents Jesus being sin free. Unleavened means sin free)
 - Passover is not a High Sabbath. You may work on it.
6. Matthew 26:17-29 (Jesus will not partake of the passover during his thousand year reign or 7th day. He will in his Father's Kingdom on the 8th day. New Testament=New Covenant. The Passover will go on as long as there are humans on this earth because that means there is sin that once repented of the Lord must passover. In the Father's Kingdom or 8th day all will be spirit beings with no more humans.)
7. 1 Corinthians 5:7-8 (Elohim gave man 7 days to exist. 6 days to do his thing and the 7th day for Yah to make man get down or lay down. All seven days though sin must be purged because wherever there is flesh and blood humans there will be sin. Before you came into the truth and got baptized you were old leaven. Now you are a new lump in Christ.)

E & M = Evening and Morning This feast reminds us that we only have 7 days (7000 years) to get it together and stop sinning.			

8. Leviticus 23:6-8 (You cannot be sin free or unleaven until after the passover)
9. Exodus 12:14-19 (The first and last day of unleavened bread are high sabbaths. You may not work/go to work on those days. You are not to buy or sell on those days. Use the day before as a prep day. You may cook on these days because you are supposed to feast.)
10. Leviticus 23:9-14 (He lamb=Jesus, Jesus is the first born/fruit of the resurrection/ground, Morrow after Sabbath=8th day)
11. John 20:1-2_11_15-17 (Mary could not touch him because he was the first fruits and had not been waved/accepted before the father yet)
12. 1 Corinthians 15:20-23 (Jesus went into the ground a man and came up a Spirit/God)
13. John 5:37-40 (All of this points to Christ)
14. Psalms 40:5-10
15. Hebrews 10:1-10
16. Leviticus 23:15-21
 - Pentecost=Fiftieth Also called Feast of Weeks
 - 7 sabbaths=49 plus the morrow after the 7th Sabbath=1 which=50
 - The wave loaves were baked with leaven representing sinful man
 - Verse 17=First Resurrection
 - 7 lambs without blemish represents those who make Christ Kingdom from the First Resurrection and those who make the Father's Kingdom from the Second Resurrection.

- Jesus rose on Sabbath or the seventh day because that is the last day of sinful flesh and blood man.

The Feast of Pentecost represents the year of the Lord's return.

17. Acts 2:1-21

- There were only Hebrew Israelites present on the day of Pentecost from all over the world who spoke different languages.
- The great & notable day of the Lord is the Day Jesus returns.
- He returns in the year of Pentecost (Jubilee)
- Rushing wind = A flock of holy angels
- Cloven tongues = the part they showed
- They interpreted for Peter in the ears of all present.
- Other tongues = other languages
- 3rd hour of the day = 9 AM
- My Spirit = Word of God

18. Leviticus 25:1-13 (Verse 8=Same formula as Pentecost, Verse 9=Day of Atonement or the Day of the Lord, Verse 10/13=Everybody will return to their own nation or vineyard according to Genesis 10 bloodlines because Jesus will separate the nations, Verse 11=Christ Millennial reign or 1000 year rest.)

19. Isaiah 13:13-14 (The aliens will properly set man's dna in order when they return to terra-form the planet. Everyone will go sit under his appropriate Y-Chromosome or nation.)

23. Leviticus 23:22-25 (Memorial Blowing of Trumpets or Feast of Trumpets. You may not work or buy/sale on this day. You are to hold a convocation. It is also a New moon. You may feast if you want but it is not required. This High Day represents the Seven Trumpets of the Tribulation with the 7th and last signifying the First Resurrection, Christ's descent to earth to reign, and the Battle of Armageddon.)

26. Joshua 6:1-17_20-27

- Ark of the Covenant=God's Word/The Law
- 7 priest with trumpets=7 Angels with trumpets
- Joshua=Jesus (Same name)
- Jericho=Mystery Babylon/The Great Whore/Rome/Vatican/European Union/Western Hegemony/Gentile Dynasty etc....
- Two Men/Spies=Angels sent to gather Spiritual Israel for First Resurrection and Physical Israelites out of their lands of captivity.

- Rahab the harlot=Church/Children of Israel (spiritual whoredom)
27. 1 Thessalonians 4:13-18
28. Leviticus 23:26-32 (Day of Atonement. This represents the Day of Jesus Return to earth and atonement he made for our sins. You may not work, eat, drink, or do anything on this day but attend the convocation. Outside of the convocation this entire day you are to spend praying and reading his word while you fast. 9th day at evening is the beginning of the 10th day. Fasting is atonement for physical bodies.)
29. Ezra 8:21 (Afflict soul=fast. Also the power/importance of this day in precept 30)
30. Isaiah 58
31. Leviticus 16:2-10_15-22 (Wilderness or land with no humans represents the third heaven where Jesus ascended to after his death, burial, and resurrection. Sacrificed goat represents Jesus death and scapegoat equals Jesus resurrection and ascension. Azael is not satan. Day of Atonement represents his crucifixion as atonement for our sins.)
32. Romans 5:6-11
- Reconciled = prepared to accept
 - Atonement = amends
 - Jesus served as both goats:
 1. He died for us
 2. He took our sins away with him to heaven
33. Joel 1:14-15 (The second coming will take place on Day of Atonement)
34. Joel 2:1-2_11-16_31-32
- Verse 1=Trumpet Blown on Day of Atonement of the 49th year to hallow the 50th year of jubilee. 7th and last trumpet of seven angels.
 - Verse 11=His army is the resurrected saints and holy angels
 - Verse 12=Fasting or Day of Atonement
 - Verse 13="And rend your heart, and not your garments" meaning worship him in spirit and truth. Obey his commandments not the traditions and precepts of man.
 - Verse 15=Day of Atonement
 - Verse 16=Bride is Spiritual Israel/First Resurrection and Physical Israelites to be gathered out of lands of captivity.
 - Verse=32 Those who survive the tribulation, Armageddon, and make it to the 1,335th day when the Jesus Millennial temple altar will be dedicated and sacrificial law reinstated. In the ninth month on the 25th day which Feast of Dedication. SEE FEAST OF DEDICATION LESSON)
35. Leviticus 23:33-36_39-44 (Feast of Tabernacles. This feast represents three things. First when Jesus will begin to gather the physical Israelites out of the lands of their captivity. Five days after his second coming and the Battle of Armageddon. Secondly it represents how mankind will dwell in flesh and blood tabernacles for seven days or 7,000 years. The last great day of the Feast or 8th day represents when the Father's Kingdom comes with New Jerusalem. At that time all will be spirit beings either in his Kingdom or in the lake of fire. On the first day and eighth day is a convocation/sabbath which means no working and buying or selling. Cooking for the feasts may be done. Days 2-7 Cooking,

buying or selling, and lawful pleasure may be done. Even if the weekly Sabbath falls during this time because we are to rejoice for Seven days.)

36. Deuteronomy 16:9-16

37. Deuteronomy 31:9-13 (The gathered physical Israelites will be read the "Law" before entering the wilderness for the purge. Jesus will complete the second half of his week of ministry there in the wilderness during the purging for 3 ½ years. This reading of the law will take place every seven years during the millennial reign.)

38. Luke 22:13-18 (Kingdom of God=Father's Kingdom which comes on 8th Day, Jesus will not partake of the passover during his Kingdom because his work is not finished yet and there are still flesh and blood humans during his millennial reign that need passing over. He will partake again in the Father's Kingdom on the 8th day.)

39. Revelation 20 (The 1,000 year reign will start and end on Day of Atonement in the Seventh month. Afterwards the Gentiles will attempt to attack the Aliens/Zombies and human members of the body of Christ while they are gathered for the Feast of Tabernacles. When this last Feast of Tabernacles has ended on the 8th day comes Judgement Day and the Father's Kingdom/New Jerusalem.)

40. Revelation 21:1-4

41. Exodus 12:1-9_12-14_29-32_43-50 (Lamb put up on 10th day)

- The blood represents the blood of Jesus, which sprung Israel from Egypt (bondage).
- The blood of Jesus liberated Israel in Egypt physically and his blood liberates all of his servants spiritually who come under his blood through baptism.

42. Joshua 4:1-3_19-23

- The people came out of Jordan on the 10 day of the first month and went to the land of Canaan (Promised Land), which is a prototype of the Kingdom of God (New Jerusalem).
- At the beginning of the Passover, God dried up a sea, and he did it again with the Jordan River.

43. Joshua 5:1-10

- Circumcision = rolling away of our flesh and blood bodies on the 8th day.
- The Circumcision is both physical & spiritual
 - Physical = Rolling away of foreskin
 - Spiritual = Rolling away of flesh & blood bodies
 - Both take place on an 8th day.
- This is why all males must be circumcised before partaking of the Passover.
- If you don't have FAITH, at the END of your day (the day you die) you will be cut off (end up in the lake of fire).
- Our journey started on the Passover and it will end on the Passover in the Father's kingdom (8th Day).

45. John 7:1-6_14-15_37 (Our time=day we die, Last day equal 8th Day and completion of the Passover. Man sinned on the first day with Adam and our sins must be passovered from days 1-7. Jesus will partake of the Passover [Bread and Wine. There will be no more meat eating in the Father's Kingdom because there are no more animals/flesh and blood/killing. Manna and Wine.] on the 8th day)
