

Zealots: Jesus and His Day Ones

1. Titus 2:11-14 (Zealots make the First Resurrection .Zealots have proven themselves to be ride or die with Elohim)
 - that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people=First Resurrection
 - Zealous of Good Works=Uncompromising when it comes to the commandments
2. Revelation 3:13-22
 - Lukewarm=non-Zealous
 - gold tried in the fire=Putting in work for the set
 - White raiment=Your colors, your flag, your rag. Your set's attire. You need this to make the First Resurrection. And just like a gang you must put in work to get it.
 - be zealous therefore=Circumspect
3. Psalms 119:138-140
 - Righteousness=Keeping the commandments
 - Verse 139=Those around you who transgress the law should cause a zeal in you for Yah's law. Light cannot cohabit with darkness

 - Verse 6=Biblical definition of a Zealot
6. Isaiah 59:15-20 (Jesus/Yah is a Zealot)

 - David prayed this after the sin of adultery and murder. How do you receive these tender mercies I.E. Yah doing you a solid? You got to be a day one with him. A zealot. David was willing to fight Yah's battles literally. And he did so with faith and no fear. After defeating goliath he had to wait to become King. Henever wavered even with Saul constantly trying to kill him. Once King he brought under vassalage to Israel the nations Yah wanted destroyed.
11. 1 Samuel 17:1-11_13-14_16-58
 - David being willing to kill a bear and lion over one lamb indicates his family was poor. Before David became King he was poor. See 1 Samuel 18:23. Jesus day ones usually come out of poverty because they have had to exercise faith.

 - David received tender mercy from Yah by Yah killing his baby instead of David
14. Acts 6:7-15 (Paul)
 - Before Paul accepted Christ and the New Covenant he was Zealot for the Old Covenant. Yah saw his zealousness and converted him. Paul brought that same zeal to Christside. All throughout the latter half of Acts you can read about Paul putting in work for the set.

 - Paul was ride or die
20. Matthew 4:17-22 (Peter)
 - Jesus appealed to the working class man
 - Peter shows he is down to ride by dropping everything in a moment to follow Christ. Most other people would not be willing to do that. See precept below.

 - Peter is so Zealous he tells Jesus that he will not die
23. Matthew 14:22-33
 - Peter is so Zealous he is willing to attempt walking on water to follow Christ. Even though he started lack faith and then drowning this showed Yah he was ride or die.
 - Verse 33=Worship the Elohim. Both the father and the son

 - John 18:10
 - Even though he denied Christ three times Peter had those tender mercies

 - Peter so Zealous over the law the tells God no three times
 - For being a dead one Peter was set over the Church at Jerusalem.
