STEWARDSHIP

We all know the person, don't we? Hey, maybe we've even been that person.

"I have a great relationship with God, but I don't go to church regularly. God and I are on good terms. I can talk to Him just fine on my own."

There isn't anything false in these statements. It's important to have an intimate, even conversational prayer relationship with God. Family? How can we serve our parish, always remembering that the table is not meant to be set only for two?

10 PRAYERS FOR EVERY CATHOLIC CHILD
