

They probably had different customs, different prayers, different languages, and even very different clothes. There is a legend that says that they were a European, an African, and an Asian. They legend also says that one was an old man, one a middle-aged man, and the third a young man. Thus, the three of them represent all of us, the whole human family on earth. Their visit reminds us that Jesus, even from his birth, came to love the whole human family, to love each of us, no matter where we are from.
