NEW AUXILIARY BISHOP

Pope Leo XIV has transferred Auxiliary Bishop Arturo Cepeda, 56, a native of San Antonio, from the Detroit Archdiocese back to the Archdiocese of San Antonio to continue his ministry as an auxiliary bishop, it was announced by the Vatican on August 26th.

Bishop Cepeda, 56, will assist Archbishop Gustavo Gustavo Garcia-Siller, MspS; as well as Auxiliary Bishop Michael Boulette and Auxiliary Bishop Gary Janak, in the administration of the archdiocese. Archbishop Gustavo has since 2010 served as chief shepherd for the more than one million Catholics who reside in the 19 counties of the archdiocese.

This historic appointment brings Bishop Cepeda back home, where he was ordained a priest in 1996. He currently serves as auxiliary bishop of Detroit and now returns to minister to the 1.16 million Catholics across 19 counties in South-Central Texas.
