Jesus' Body and Blood are not just symbols — they are the very presence of God made real, inviting us to love, serve, and stay close to Him.

This reflection can be linked to the Eucharist, especially the words of consecration in the Mass: *"This is my Body... This is my Blood."* It also echoes the Passion narrative, where Jesus gave Himself fully for humanity — a love so complete that it becomes the source of life and unity for all believers.

Jesus' Body and Blood are the living heart of the Church. They remind us that He is present in the breaking of bread, in the sharing of food, and in the love we show to others. His sacrifice on the Cross is not distant history — it is the foundation of our faith and the source of our spiritual nourishment Saint John's Seminary.

Sacrificial Love – Like Jesus, we are called to give ourselves for others, even when it's hard.

Unity in the Body of Christ – The Eucharist unites us as one family in God.
