- **Mission**: To preserve and celebrate African-American history, culture, and contributions in Cabarrus and Rowan Counties.
- **Vision**: A permanent, community-centered museum and cultural center for generations to come.
- 501(c)(3) Status: Yes, EIN available upon request. All donations are tax-deductible.

### **2.** What Can Be Underwritten

- Signature Events (e.g., Women of a New Tribe, Annual Hall of Fame Inductions)
- Educational Programs & Lecture Series
- Historical Exhibitions
- Community Conversations on Education, Equity & Access
- Digital Initiatives (e.g., website, media, oral histories)
- Publications (e.g., Cabarrus-Rowan Who's Who Magazine)
- Operating Support or Equipment/Technology Sponsorship

## **☑** 3. Levels of Underwriting Support

Underwriting can be customized based on the initiative. Sample tiers:

- **Presenting Underwriter** \$25,000+
- **Major Program Underwriter** \$10,000–\$24.999
- Community Engagement Sponsor \$5,000–\$9,999
- **Education Supporter** \$1,000–\$4,999
- Legacy Partner Up to \$999

Note: You may adapt these based on current needs and funder feedback.

## **✓** 4. Benefits of Being an Underwriter

- Logo/name recognition on materials, website, and social media
- Verbal recognition at events
- Complimentary tickets or access (based on level)
- Featured article/interview in a future newsletter, magazine, or blog.
- Association with a community-based, culturally rich mission
- Tax acknowledgment letter and annual impact report
