This year Andona will be awarding six \$2,000 scholarships to graduates of the Class of 2025 whose legal, principal residence is in the town of Andover. These scholarships are for one year only and are to be applied to the recipient's first year of post high school education. Recipients will be invited to Andona's Annual Scholarship dinner (Thursday, June 5th).

All components of the applications should be submitted by email to scholarships@andona.org by **Friday, March 7, 2025** (late or incomplete applications will not be considered).

Please include the information below with your completed application. All components may be emailed together or sent in separately by the appropriate party. Please include applicant's name in the subject line. All applications must be typed (handwritten applications will not be considered). Please send documents and the application in **PDF format**. Include the following:

- ◆ Completed Application
- ◆ Email address not connected to your school to reach you in the future
- ◆ College Application Essay (with name on essay). **At the top of the essay please include the essay prompt to which you were responding.**
- ◆ Teacher Recommendation (at least one, may submit two)
- ◆ Guidance Counselor Recommendation (from current school)
- ◆ Personal Recommendation (from a community service director, employer, coach, club advisor, or other non-relative)
- ◆ Official High School Transcript(s) from all high schools attended. **Transcript must include 1st semester senior year grades.**
- ◆ Resume (optional)
