

QUALIFICATION COURSE OF FIRE

Fifty(50) round New York State DCJS qualification course of fire requires a passing score of 70 percent using factory ammunition.

25 yard line – 8 rounds fired in 40 seconds with reload

15 yard line – 12 rounds fired in 40 seconds with reload

7 yard line – 18 rounds fired in two phases:

Phase 1 – 6 rounds fired in two rounds increments – no time limit

Phase 2 – 12 rounds fired in 25 seconds with reload

3 yard line – 12 rounds fired in two phases:

Phase 1 – 6 rounds fired in two round increments – no time limit

Phase 2 – 6 rounds fired in 6 seconds or less

The above qualification course is designed for six shoot revolvers. Five shot revolvers are more difficult to qualify with, **if at all possible use a six Shot Service Type Revolver**. Reloading devices are recommended but are not required. Semi-automatic shooters are required to have a **minimum of two magazines**.
