#### **ANN (NELSON) KAARI**



Patrick Henry High School, North Minneapolis, Public Education, and the PHHS Foundation recently lost a friend, colleague, and super supporter. Ann Kaari was a lifelong resident of north Minneapolis. She attended Jenny Lind Elementary and graduated from Patrick Henry High School in 1960. She married long time classmate Warren Kaari. Ann lived her whole life continually working to improve the Victory neighborhood and Minneapolis Public schools.

She spent countless hours as an active member of Jenny Lind PTA and as a tutor. She was involved with scouting along with her husband and two sons Stephen and Timothy. Ann was the first Minnesota woman to receive the Boy Scout's prestigious Order of the Arrow award.

Ann still found more time in her busy schedule to be active in the Victory Neighborhood Association and Our Neighborhood Works. She found great joy in bringing the neighborhood together for Holiday on 44<sup>th</sup> each year, which she helped get started.

As the president of the Minneapolis School Board for 12 years, she continued her fight for Minneapolis public schools and worked to make sure that North Minneapolis schools were never neglected. She was always able to see the big picture and address the current needs as well as having a vision for the long-term success of her favorite passion, students. Leading the district as a board member was not enough for Ann, she also found to volunteer at the district's annual spelling bee and History Day competition. According to Warren, she "wanted the best for all students" so "she stuck her nose in there and fought for the best".

Ann helped found and establish the Patrick Henry High School Foundation in 1999 in order to serve PHHS students further with everyday needs, classroom needs, and scholarships to further education. She was inducted into the Patrick Henry Hall of Fame in 2001.

Her passing leaves a large hole in the fabric of PHHS, North Minneapolis, the PHHS Foundation and public education in Minneapolis.
