Dear Henry Foundation Members,

On behalf of my biology students at Patrick Henry High School I would like to express sincere gratitude for your generous donation towards the fetal pig dissections in our science laboratory.

Your donation enabled students to have an enriching educational experience, allowing them to engage in hands-on learning while gaining a deeper understanding of the anatomy and physiology of these animals that are so similar to humans. For ten days in February and March, 140 students eagerly worked in collaborative pairs while dissecting fetal pigs. They safely used the tools of a surgeon as they learned about the various organs, organ systems, and the tissues of which these are composed. The hearts and the kidneys of the specimens were set aside for an even more in-depth observational study which was completed recently.

The opportunity to perform these dissections was so exciting that sometimes students walked briskly from the classroom to the lab so that they could spend as much time as possible working. Their focus was intense, especially on the day of the first incision. Students have been encouraged to pursue careers in the medical field, especially surgery, and many said they had not really thought about it before but are now interested. Students have also come to more fully appreciate and understand their own bodies which will undoubtedly lead them to take good care of their health for their entire lives.

This valuable learning experience was only possible because of your donations. Your generosity and commitment to education are truly appreciated and have had a significant impact on students. We are incredibly grateful for your support.
