

FL Investment fund was created to provide a more appealing offer to individuals that are looking to help me reach my goal of becoming a professional IndyCar driver. FL Investment fund is a way to invest in my career through private equity and succeed financially when my IndyCar career begins.

To invest in FL Investment fund, we are selling shares at \$25,000 per unit and there are roughly 200 units. It would be amazing if we could sell all 200 units and raise 5 million dollars but obviously it is not very realistic to think this will happen very easily. 5 million dollars is the theoretical goal that is set because it is roughly the amount it would take for me to spend another 2 years in the ladder system and then the expense for my first full time season in IndyCar. With this being said, there is a lot we can do with a small number of shares as it would get the ball rolling and hopefully create more momentum for more investors to join.

Once I start to make money on anything racing related, investors get 65% of it and will continue to get 65% of my earnings until they break even on their investment. Once they have broken even, they will continue to get paid 35% of my earnings until the end of the agreement (10-15 year long agreement).

"Example: Assume all 198 units are sold totaling \$4,950,000 in capital. Flinn Lazier has combined revenues from; driver salary, endorsements, image rights, merchandise sales, etc. after operating expenses of \$2,500,000 annually. The annual return to the Fund is \$1,625,000 (65%) of earnings. At this rate the Fund would be paid back 100% of original investment in 3.1 years" (FL Investment Fund, 47).

Other benefits for investors at the track and off the track are the same as a regular sponsorship as well (if you would like them to be). This consists of but is not limited to rights to the design of the car, my helmet, suit, team apparel, team hauler designed, and logos. Investors will also have full access to every race along with hospitality from the team and Indy Racing League. I will also be available for any appearances desired from investors. If this is something you don't desire than that is fine as well.

We have created FL Investment fund in an effort to launch my professional career as I have gotten so far and am not going to stop now. Funding is always the biggest hurdle for drivers starting their professional career and I know when I get my chance, I will be able to make the most of it. By being an investor, you can help me achieve my dream and we can succeed together.

Right now there are only 2 other drivers in the United States offering this program to investors but this is not the first time something like this has been done. 2016 Indy 500 winner, Alexander Rossi's father is the one who created this program for his son when he was coming through the ranks. They raised over 5 million dollars and Alex has had a lot of success, his investors broke even years ago and are still profiting from Alex's income today. I know if I got the chance I could have as much if not more success then Alex had, and as I've done in the past, I know how to make a lot out of a little which is why anything and everything can help to get me one step closer to my goal.
