Triggs Ladies Inner Club Club Championship 2022

This year, we have made some changes to our Club Championship using input from all of you! We hope you will be interested in participating in our Club Championship.

(Please note, according to our Bylaws - Article 5 Section 4 - Eligibility to participate in the Club Championship: In order to qualify a member must have played in five events from the previous year or two events prior to the Club Championship qualifying date of the current year.)

This year, you will need two days of stroke play to be eligible for participation in the Club Championship. You must play these rounds during our regular weekend dates. *You will have until Sunday, July 17th to qualify and turn in two scores.* The week of July 18^{th,} the brackets will be put together and posted in time to begin match play the weekend of July 25th.

It is our hope to have three divisions with eight players in each. From this point, you will begin Match Play. *You may schedule match play during weekly tournaments or any time convenient for both players during the week.* These divisions will **NOT** be handicapped. You will **NOT** be eligible to participate in the weekly tournament and ringer competitions if you are playing Match Play. You will however be eligible to participate in the birdie and chip in competition (the ball must be putted into the hole for a birdie) as well as any other closest to the pin or long drive competitions.

The following will be our schedule for Match Play & Finals:

1st Round Match Play – played by Sunday August, 7th.
2nd Round Match Play – played by Sunday, August 28th.
Finals - will be played either September 10th or 11th or September 17th or 18th. This will allow for rain dates.

If we need a rain date(s), everyone will be notified of any changes or updates.

Qualifying Rounds

You must declare the morning of, prior to hitting your first ball, that you will be qualifying that day. Just let someone in your group know you are qualifying for the Club Championship. Please make sure you are keeping a separate scorecard and write on the top of the scorecard, *Club Championship – make sure your name is on there and the date.* Someone in your group must sign the scorecard as well as you. Please give or take a picture of your scorecard and get it to either Catherine or Lori at the end of the day you played.

Everything must be holed out. Count every stroke. If people plan to qualify on dates where the weekly tournament has a *format where a player is playing their own ball, then they will be eligible for that weekly tournament*.

ADDENDUM TO TRIGGS LADIES CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP Effective August 7, 2021

Caddies

Under the USGA Rules of Golf - 10.3 – caddies are not allowed to play while caddying.

ADDENDUM

A local rule for this year will now allow Caddies to caddy during the Triggs Ladies Club Championship Match Play **AND** play in the weekly tournaments.

Under this local rule, any player (caddie or not) will allow the Match Play players to putt out from the fringe to the hole **first** before play continues on that hole for non-caddies and caddies.
