# **RECIPE FOR THE MONTH:**

# **Apple Crisp**



#### Ingredients:

- 5 Honeycrisp, Granny Smith, and/or Cripp's Pink apples, peeled, cored, sliced 1/4" to 1/2" thick
- 2 tbsp. cornstarch
- 2 tbsp. fresh lemon juice
- 2 tbsp. granulated sugar
- 1/4 tsp. ground nutmeg
- 2 tsp. ground cinnamon, divided
- **1 1/2 c.** (135 g.) rolled oats
- 3/4 c. (160 g.) packed light brown sugar
- **2/3 c.** (80 g.) all-purpose flour
- 1/4 tsp. kosher salt
- 3/4 c. (1 1/2 sticks) unsalted butter, melted
- Vanilla ice cream, for serving (optional)

#### Directions:

- Preheat oven to 350°. In a medium bowl, toss apples, cornstarch, lemon juice, granulated sugar, nutmeg, and 1 teaspoon cinnamon.
- In a small bowl, toss oats, brown sugar, flour, salt, and remaining 1 teaspoon cinnamon. Add butter and stir until a crumbly mixture form resembling wet sand.
- Arrange apple mixture in a 2-quart ceramic baking dish. Top with oat mixture.
- Bake until apples are soft, topping is crisp and golden brown, and juices are bubbling around edges of dish, 55 to 70 minutes. Serve warm with ice cream (if using).

#### **FUN FACTS:**


- A turkey miscalculation birthed the first TV dinner.
