

1.Holy Spirit filled the members



Cells in Early Church & In History


- Many responded and taken into home cells






1. Community – (Its All About Relationship!)

3. Edification (Accountability)

"But select capable men from all the people—...—and appoint them as officials over thousands, hundreds, fifties and tens."



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Roles & Responsibilities Cell Group Leader

Cell Ministry

- Urgent Time is NOW!
 - Luke 19:10 "To seek & save what was lost"
 - John 4:35 "Four months more & the harvest?"
- Sole motivation for growth. No GAME.
 - Eternal state of those who don't know Jesus
- Everyone is a minister
 - Ephesians 4:11-12 "Leadership is to prepare God's people for service"
 - Revelations 1:6 "Christ made us a kingdom of priests"

Joel Comiskey's Survey

Factors that Do Not Affect Multiplication

- Leader's gender, social class, age, marital status, or education
- Leader's personality type
 - Introverted and extroverted multiply
- Leader's spiritual gifting
 - Teaching, pastoring, mercy, leadership, and evangelism equally multiply

Factors That Affect Multiplication

- Leader's Prayer Life
 - Devotional Time (90 vs. 30 mins twice multiplication)
 - Pray daily for cell members
 - Time with God (preparing heart for meeting) more important than preparing lessons
- Setting Goals & knowing multiplication date
 - Increase chances by 75%
- Training & Raising up New Leaders (Interns)
- Evangelistic Thrust
 - Contacts new people, invite friends, Outside meetings, pastoral care

Cell Group Leader's Role

Personal Commitment Responsibilities

- Read & meditate on bible daily
- Pray daily for pastors, coach, cell, family, harvest
- Attend at least one prayer meeting during week
- Attend Sunday cluster/celebration service (2-winged)

Cell Leaders are Shepherds

- Call of the Heart of a Shepherd (John 10:11-15)
 - Shepherd vs. hired hands
 - Not "Super Christians" nor "Super Bible Teacher"
- Characteristics of Shepherd (Ez 34:1-6)
 - Community
 - Know the sheep (John 10:14-15)
 - Evangelism
 - Seek the lost sheep (Luke 15:4, Ez 34)
 - Leadership/Equipping
 - Feed, strengthen, heal up the sheep (Psalms 23, Ez 34)
 - Set goals & vision
 - Edification (Accountability)
 - Watch Out for the sheep (John 10:10)
 - Care for sheep (Acts 20:28-29)

Cell Leader's Prayer Life

Cell Leaders & Prayer

- Joel's Survey: 90 Mins of Prayer, twice as fast
 - Logical: Jesus did (Luke 5:15, Mark 1:35)
 - Hear God's voice, leadership, & guidance (1 Chronicles 14:10-17 David)
- Cell leaders moving under God's guidance has clear sense of direction & leadership.
- Cell members respond and follow leaders who hear from God.
- Place where treasures are found (Matthew 6:5-6)
 - "Pray in secret, Father reward openly"

Order in Prayer Closest

- Goal is to know Him
 - Time with friend... do we have agenda?
 - Philippians 3:10 "Want to know Christ & the power of.."
- Start with worship (Music and/or praise) or with the reading of His Word
 - Most times, this will give us direction & guidance
 - Approach him and speak to him as a friend
- Time of listening (Listening room)
 - God will speak thru thoughts & ideas
 - Journal. Enjoy His presence. Keep Simple.
- Pray for cell members & visitors individually
 - Open our hearts to touch them at a deeper level
 - Ask God to help strengthen them thru a word of encouragement
 - Let them know that you are praying for them

Prayer Pre - Cell

- As part of the preparation, encourage core members to pray and fast that day (or a meal)
- The gifts of the Holy Spirit must be an integral part of the meeting.
 - Pray that God will release His gifts to minister to and edify the cell
- The cell is the ideal place to minister and practice the gifts to edify, comfort, and strengthen the body (1 Corinthians 12, 13, 14)
- The Holy Spirit will move as He wills. We are to pray that hindrances will be removed.
- Pre-Cell prayer will give you boldness to flow in Holy Spirit and create atmosphere for God to move.

Prayer in the Cell Group

- No "right way" to pray in cell. Be creative. Following are samples:
 - Break into groups of 2-3.
 - Allows for more people to pray, less intimidating.
 - Train members to pray short conversational like prayers
 - Allows for greater interaction & agreement
 - Ask individual to intercede
 - Cell leader could give a topic, and ask each person or group to pray quietly or in concert fashion (Everyone praying at the same time).
 - There must be a prayer of agreement before continuing with next topic.

Prayer Walks

- Is getting your cell to penetrate their environment with prayer. Following are the characteristics:
 - Helps move the body into the community
 - Provides cell with unexpected contacts with unbelievers
 - Helps increase aware of neighborhood
 - Helps obtain vision for neighborhood
 - Invades Satan's territory
 - Demonstrates a visible banner of righteousness in public
 - Encourages & strengthen cell fellowship, unity

Guidelines for Prayer Walks

- Plan for the walk, including planned routes.
 - Break into smaller groups if necessary.
- Pray together in private before the prayer walk
 - Prepare by coming to His presence thru praise/worship
 - Confess sins and ask for forgiveness
 - Claim God's protection over selves and homes
 - Pray for wisdom and in-filling of Holy Spirit
 - Pray for the people there. Ask Spirit to touch their hearts, convict them of sins, lead them to repentance, and send someone to lead them to Christ
 - If they sense or experience a strange or evil feeling at a location. Note that place. Follow up by coming against the spirit of darkness there.
- Establish time for group to come back
- End with praise and thanksgiving

Cell Facilitation


How to Be a Facilitator

Ephesians 4:15-16

- Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will in all things grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.
- Provides experience or application for each part to do its work for the building up of the body.
- Goal is to facilitate ministry not for leader to "do" the ministry
- Allows God to work thru the group
- Discussion leads to the application of truth

Effective Facilitation

- Studies shown that 60% communication comes thru body language
- Effectiveness begins with proper physical surrounding
 - Circle without distraction
- Effectiveness continues with "listening"
 - Seek 1st to understand
 - Ask others what they think before you share
 - Don't plan what to say, while others are talking
 - Affirm what people share (not necessarily agree)
 - Restate what you heard
- Show interest with posture
 - Lean forward, nod, don't cross arms
 - Watch people's reactions



Dealing with Problem People

Negative Person

- Challenge them directly & give responsibility
- Make them aware of what they are doing
- Encourage them by emphasizing their value in kingdom
- Ask if you can assist them to overcome their negativity

Continually Sick Person

- Check 1st on obvious: eat properly, enough sleep
- Pray to see if it's a spiritual or emotional ailment
- Take them to leadership for prayer
- If they're serious about healing, ask them to pray & fast
- Pray and fast with them

Dealing with Problem People

Overly Talkative Person (Insensitive to others)

- Interrupt and thank them for input. Now would like to hear from others.
- Share with them after the cell, that the purpose of the cell is to provide everyone with a chance to provide input
- Encourage them not to stop sharing, but they must allow others opportunity to share

Cuddling (Mainly youth)

- Correct them in private
- Tell them to sit at opposite ends
- Encourage them that they are there for others not just themselves
- Give them added responsibilities

Dealing with Problem People

- Argumentative People (Doctrine Debaters)
 - Do not address them in public and try to correct them, but ask them to hold questions till after the meeting
 - Let him understand that it's not edifying and only causes confusion.
 - Never assume the problem alone. It's the cell's problem.

- And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds. Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another...
- Helps us understand the purpose for home cells
 - Deficiency: Lack of sharing and personal interaction
- Cell Agenda: To keep main thing the main thing
 - Love One Another Edify (Inward)
 - Love Others Evangelize (Outward)
 - Make Disciples Mentoring (Up)

The Cell Group Agenda: Welcome

- Prepare group to focus on Lord and one another
- Activity for everyone to participate in
- Icebreakers
 - Help bind people together
 - Break initial resistance
 - Takes 1st step to enter into another's life
 - Not a waste of time. Laughter is a medicine.
- For first time visitors, it's useful to prolong this phase
 - "Where did you grow up between 7 & 12?"
 - "Who was the person closest to you"
 - "When did God become more than a word to you?"
 - "What's your favorite..?"
- Watch for crisis during this time
 - "My mother died". Circle back to this...

The Cell Group Agenda: Worship

Guidelines

- Lead by examples. Worship from your heart.
- Focus on God, ascribing Him worth and value
- Worship involves faith. Expects God to be there.
- Be prepared.
- Avoid songs that you and your cell members are not familiar with.
 - (Introduce no more than one new song)
- Be open to the Holy Spirit.
- Testimonies and Scriptural reading can be used in worship
- CDs music is a good option for groups without instruments

- 1Corinthians 8:1 "Knowledge makes one arrogant, but love edifies."
- The Word time is not intended to merely be a Bible study. It is meant as a time
 of edification.
 - Each person must learn to edify, using their spiritual gifts in building up the body (1Corinthians 14:26)
 - Focus on the application of the scripture passage from previous Sunday
 - Facilitate and not teach. Teaching is the leader doing all the talking.
 Facilitating is the leader getting people to talk.
 - Discussion and sharing: Lead the people to applications that are: personal, specific, and practical. Also a time of ministry thru prayer and the exercising of the gifts.

3 Types of People (In regard to edification)

1. Those wanting to be edified

 These are members who come with the expectations that their hurts, pains, and needs will be solved by the group

2. Those waiting to be edified

- These are neutral people, waiting for God or someone to edify

3. Those desiring to edify

- These are the people who come prepared to bless others. They want to be used by God to edify others.
- All cell members should be encouraged to be type 3 edifier

1 Corinthians 14:26

• So here's what I want you to do. When you gather for worship, each one of you be prepared with something that will be useful for all: Sing a hymn, teach a lesson, tell a story, lead a prayer, provide an insight.

Everyone is encouraged to participate

- Ask the more reserved individuals for their opinions
- "I would really like to know what X think/feel about this"
- Thank the extroverted for their participation and continue by saying that you now would like to hear what others think.
- Focus on fact that everyone's input is important

- Use of Spiritual Gifts in the cell are for edification, exhortation, and comfort of the body.
- No rebuke, negative words or prophesy over cell members is not allowed
- Be sensitive to people's feelings
 - If an issue is really sensitive, then deal with it in private
 - Deal with coach or pastor present
- Regularly remind the group, that participation means agreement to keep situations shared confidential.
- Transparency is encouraged. Sharing details is not.
- Gossip is a sin. (2 Corinthians 12:20)

The Cell Group Agenda: Witness

- Transition from "How God wants to minister to us" to "How God wants to minister through us"
- Time of preparation, planning, and prayer for the witness and work of the ministry
- Each (core) member should be actively involved in planning the strategy for winning people to Lord
- What can take place in this section?
 - Be a BI FSSING!
 - Pray for unsaved family, friends (ie. Blessing list)
 - Name a person they would like to approach the coming week
 - Plan activities to start a target group (ie. Police officers, hobby group, etc.)
 - Plan "friendship dinner" instead of normal cell
 - Plan for prayer walk or harvest event
 - Plan for ways to bless the unreached

The Cell Group Agenda: Witness

How to pray for unbelievers:

- Pray with the knowledge that Jesus paid the price on the cross for that person (Romans 5:8)
- Pray against the power of darkness upon that person's life. Pray for the veil to be removed so that the person will be able to choose freedom aside from Satan's interference. (2 Corinthians 4:3-4)
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will draw this person to Him through repentance and the conviction of sin, righteousness, and judgment. (John 16:8)
- Pray that God will bring forth circumstances, events, and people into this person's path to reveal their need for a Savior and Lord.
- Pray that God will use you as a blessing to that person to draw him/her to the Lord.

The Cell Group Agenda: Guidelines

- What is being shared in the cell group stays in cell (confidentiality & trust)
 - NO GOSSIP!
- If we have to share about someone (within or outside the cell group) in his/her absence, please share in such a way as if he/she is there.
- We are the body of Christ. If we are offended, we will choose to be open and resolve the conflict with the person.
 - We value unity in Christ.
- The cell group is a part of TOUCH Family Church. Six weeks into cell group life a decision has to be made whether God calls you into TOUCH or not.
 - Danger: Vision + Vision = Division
- No business or money dealing in the cell group nor Sunday celebration
 - Jesus said that His house is a house of prayer.

- Tend Christ's lambs (Children)
- Shepherd Christ's sheep (Young Men)

Help the Cell experience edification

Refer Extra Grace people to Supervisor

Develop New Leaders

Mentor potential leaders

Reach Out & Touch people (Evangelize)

- Identify & do the ministry

Each cell has "Little Children"

The "little children" know 2 things:

- 1. They have a father and
- 2. Their sins are forgiven.

"Little Children" may be New Christians, Hurting Christians and/or Prodigal Christians. They are to be nurtured and developed by the Cell members.

1 John 2:12-14

Each cell has "Youth"

The "youth" learned as "children" that they have a father and their sins are forgiven. However, "youth" also know that they have an enemy, and have mastered him!

"Youth" can be trained to reach out to those who are interested in God. They focus on cultivating and witnessing to Responsive Unbelievers.

1 John 2:12-14

Each cell has "Leaders"

The "leaders" know God intimately and have produced and cared for spiritual children.

It's vital that "leaders" disciple children to become "youth", and "youth" to become "leaders".

Importance of next generation - The passing on of our legacy

Identifying New Leaders

- Do they love God and one another?
- Do they have a heart to make disciples?
- Do they have FAITH(S)?
 - F: Faithful/Fearless
 - A: Available/Accountable
 - I: Integrity/Insight
 - T: Teachable/Trainable
 - H: Humble/Honest
 - S: Steadfast/Selfless
- Do they model a Christian walk?

First 9 Months of Cell Cycle

New Leader Process

- Cell leader consult with supervisor & pastor when intern is identified
- Potential leader must be faithful to cell for a season. Hands on experience is caught.
- Potential leader must show a personal desire for cell to grow.
 - Must also be able to work in a team
- Take potential leader to ministry situations to see if they are suitable
- Potential leader's availability for ministry will be indicative to his future commitment.
 - A willingness to sacrifice himself and his time is very important
- Potential leader must complete Equipping track (except 1st batch)

Cell Administration

Cell Group Reporting

- The cell report is an important source of information for supervisor and church staff to monitor the cell progress.
 - Keeps focus on 5 purposes of cell
 - Focuses on goals & vision
 - Tracks prayer and cell needs
 - Helps keeps focus on training of interns
 - Provides communication flow to supervisor
- Cell leader's responsibility to have form completed every week.
