Session 1 The Biblical Church

... is Called and Gifted

Ephesians 4:11-13

11 "And He gave some, Apostles; and some, Prophets; and some, Evangelists; and some, Pastors and Teachers; 12 For the (1) perfecting of the saints, for the (2)work of the ministry, for the (3) edifying of the body of Christ: 13 Till we all come in the (1)unity of the faith, and of the (2) knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the (3) fullness of Christ..."

Other Key Scripture: Matthew 28:19, Mark 16:15-18, Luke 24:45-49, Acts 1:8 ... Acts 2:42-47; Matthew 4:19 & 16:18.

... Is Called and Gifted

- 1. **Apostles:** Sent; a delegate, ambassador, commissioner; to plant, ground, establish the work of the church.
- 2. **Prophets:** Foreteller, vision, foresight, direction.
- 3. **Evangelists:** Preacher of the gospel.
- 4. **Pastors:** Shepherd; lead, feed, guide, protect the flock of God.
- **5. Teachers:** Instructor, doctor, master
- **6. Bishops:** Administrators, Senior Pastors, Overseers

The 5-fold ministry has all that is needed to equip the church not the individual!

*The Apostle and the Prophet are the foundation of the church!

... is Called and Gifted

- The **5-fold ministry** is also a **5-fold gift** for the local church.
- These gifts are key to the church's ability to fulfil the Great Commission.

Ephesians 4:8 "Wherefore he said, When he ascended up on high, he led captivity captive, **and** gave gifts unto men."

- If the church does not have;
 - > an **Apostle** there must still be **Apostolic order**;
 - > a **Prophet** there must still be **Prophetic leading** for the church;
 - > a **Pastor** Then sheep will be scattered without a **Shepherd**;
 - > a **Teacher** there still needs to be **teaching**!

The 5-fold ministry is key to establishing the purpose ad overall mission of the church

... is Called to Perfection, to Serve and to Build up

Ephesians 4:11

And he gave some, <u>Apostles</u>; and some, <u>Prophets</u>; and some, <u>Evangelists</u>; and some, <u>Pastors</u> and <u>Teachers</u>; 12 For the (1) <u>Perfecting of the saints</u>, for the (2) <u>Work of the ministry</u>, for the (3) <u>edifying of the body of Christ</u>: 13 Till we <u>all come</u> in the (1) <u>Unity of the faith</u>, and of the (2) <u>Knowledge of the Son of God, Unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature</u> of the (3) <u>Fullness of Christ...</u>

... is Called to Perfection, to Serve and to Build up

1. Perfecting of the saints: Complete, furnishing; mental and moral state.

Hebrews 6:1-2

- 2. Work of the ministry: Attend, Service, minister, relief. (Whole Person)
- 3. Edifying of the body of Christ: Structure, build up, confirmation. (CPR)

The saints (sacred, pure, blameless, holy) are called to be perfected (by the 5-fold ministry) to do the work of the ministry.

... is Called to Perfection, Service and Building up

- 4. Unity of the faith: Oneness, unanimity, (Hebrews 10:25)
- **5. Knowledge of the Son of God:** Recognition, full discernment, acknowledgement:
- **6. Perfect man:** Complete, growth, mental and moral character, completeness, of full age.
- 7. Measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ: Metre, limited portion, degree.



The Pentagon of Ministries (Recap)

- The 5 ministry types provide different strengths:
 - **Apostle The sent one**. Vision-keeper for the extension of the church's mission, an entrepreneur/starter. Bring strategic skills, risk taking, and get things off the ground.
 - **Prophet Providing a God's eye view**. Provides the church community with challenge and a call to covenant faithfulness. Strong on advocacy, justice, prayer.
 - Evangelist Gifted Communicators of the good news to unbelievers. Drives growth, ensures the call to salvation is made.
 - Shepherd/Pastor Comforters/Encouragers. Provides stability, a sense of connectedness, loving community, discipleship.
 - **Teacher Explainers of Truth**. Providers of depth, discernment and focused on maturity.

The DNA of the Church



Acts 2:42-47 And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers 43 And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

44 And all that believed were together, and had all things common; 45 And sold their possessions and goods, and parted them to all men, as every man had need.

46 And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart, 47 Praising God, and having favour with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily such as should be saved.

Modern Day Apostles

The Five-Fold Ministry

- Pastors and Teachers are SETTLERS.
- Apostles, Prophets, and Evangelists, are PIONEERS.
- An Apostle births things.
 - Leaders
 - Churches
 - Ministries
 - Doctrine
- An Apostle sets things in order. (Titus 1:5)
- An Apostle is a SPIRITUAL LEADER. (1 Corinthians 4:14-21)
- An Apostle moves in signs and wonders. (2 Corinthians 12:12)

Modern Day Apostles

The Five-Fold Ministry

- Ministries need to be balanced to avoid their weak points becoming damaging or distorting to the expression of faith:
 - If Apostles Dominate risk of "tiring Christianity", wounding people due to autocratic style/future-orientation, too much challenge
 - If Prophets Dominate risk of "one-dimensional Christianity", with a 'hobby horse feel' and being either overly driven or otherworldly
 - If Evangelists Dominate risk of "shallow Christianity", simplistic faith that does not deepen into real discipleship
 - If Shepherds/Pastors Dominate risk of "safe Christianity", inward-focus, not enough challenge
 - If Teachers Dominate risk of "dry Christianity", intellectualism, and dogmatism

The DNA of the Church

The DNA of the Church Acts 2:42-47

- •There are 12 KEY functions of the church found in this passage of text.
- These functions were both personal and corporate experiences and practices for the early church.
- •These functions can also be viewed as the DNA of the early church, therefore it's the model for all generations.
- •The church of the Kingdom must embrace the principles and practice of this Model in order to fulfil the true vision of the Great Commission.


The DNA of the Church

The Fellowship of the Believers *Acts 2:42-47*

⁴² They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. ⁴³ Everyone was filled with awe at the many wonders and signs performed by the apostles. ⁴⁴ All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ They sold property and possessions to give to anyone who had need. ⁴⁶ Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.




What is a discipleship?

A Disciple is:

- **D** Disciplined in his/her relationship with God (2 Timothy 2:15)
 - **I** Involved in a gathering of believers (Hebrews 10:25)
 - **S** Spirit-filled & Spirit led (Romans 8:14, Ephesians 5:18)
 - **C** Concerned for others rather than self (Philippians 2:3-4)
 - I Involved in serving in his/her area of giftedness (1 Peter 4:11)
 - **P** Prayerful in all things (Philippians 4:6-7, 1 Thessalonians 5:17)
 - L Leading others to become disciples (2 Timothy 2:2)
 - **E** Enjoying God always (Isaiah 61:10, 1 Thessalonians 5:16)
