

Michigan Children's Camp Central Registry Clearance Instructions

A Central Registry clearance is required for Children's Camp staff and unsupervised volunteers who are 21 years of age or older. To request a clearance, go to www.michigan.gov/ccbc-camps and click Create New Account. If you have previously made an account, you should proceed to log in.







Enter your chosen email and password on the next page and click Register.




You will then receive an email with a link to verify your email address.



On the next screen click, "Continue," to go to the log in screen and log in with the email address and password you selected previously.





Once you are logged in, select Request Camps Central Registry Clearance.



Enter your information into the form. You must add all aliases (previous names) onto the form. If you have a Social Security Number, it must be listed as well.


Purpose: This request for Central Registry clearance is submitted to the Child Care Background Check Unit to determine if a camp staff member/volunteer who is 21 years of age or older is not named in a central registry case as a perpetrator of child abuse or child neglect in the state of Michigan as required by MCL 722.119. 
Continue completing the form. Once you are done, click Review.

The next screen is a review page showing all the information you entered on the form. If everything is correct, click Submit. If you need to make changes, click Edit.




If the CCBC Unit requires additional information to process your request, you will receive the following email (this situation is very rare).




Click the link in the email, log in to your account and then click View to see the letter detailing the additional information needed. Information should be submitted to MiLEAP-CCBC@michigan.gov.



Once your request is fully processed, you will receive another email.



Click the link in the email, log in, and click View to see the results of your request.



If your clearance was granted, you can now download or print your letter, and provide it to the camp. You can also click Share, and enter the email address of the person with whom you want to share the clearance. This option will send that person a direct link to your clearance letter.

Dear JACOB POYNTER:

You requested a central registry clearance be performed on you for the purposes of working or volunteering for a licensed Children's Camp or Campsite. The results of this search indicate that as of 5/1/2025 there is no record of you being identified as a perpetrator of child abuse and/or neglect on the Child Abuse/Neglect Central Registry system in the State of Michigan.

If your request was denied, you should **not** send your letter to the camp. The letter details how to request an expungement of a Central Registry case. Once expunged, you can submit a new Central Registry clearance request to the CCBC Unit.
