If leadership is a calling from God, what happens if I don't step into it?



Answer:

When we don't respond to God's call, the mission suffers. Ang mga taong sana'y naging disipulo sa pamamagitan natin ay maaaring hindi na marinig ang Ebanghelyo sa personal na paraan.

Matthew 9:37 says, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few."

If we don't lead, the harvest is wasted. But when we say YES, God equips us—leadership is not about our ability, it's about our obedience.

**Why should I share my whole life and
not just teach the Bible?**



Answer:

Because discipleship is caught, not just taught. People grow when they see Christ in our everyday walk, not only in our words.

1 Thessalonians 2:8 says, “We were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well.”

If we only teach but don’t live it, discipleship becomes theory. But when we share life-to-life, discipleship becomes transformation.

they might be with Him
and that He might send
them out to preach.’**

- **To see every leader raise their 12, who will also raise their 12, until multitudes are discipled.**



**Why aim for 12 primaries? Isn't leading
one group enough?**



Answer:

Jesus Himself showed the pattern—He raised 12 who became world changers (Mark 3:14).

If we only lead a small group without multiplying, the movement stops with us. But when we dream and pray for 12, we are aligning with Jesus' vision of multiplication.

One leader can reach dozens; twelve leaders can reach hundreds. Our dream for 12 is God's dream for nations.
