

THE BIBLE'S DOCTRINE OF ANGELS

- 1) Angels are created beings; the Holy Spirit is God.
 - Angels were created by God (Colossians 1:16)
 - The Holy Spirit is not created—He is the third Person of the Trinity (Acts 5:3-4, Matthew 28:19

- 2) Angels serve outside of us; the Holy Spirit dwells within us.
 - Angels can be sent to protect, guide, or minister (Psalm 91:11, Hebrews 1:14).
 - But the Holy Spirit lives in every believer's heart (1 Corinthians 6:19).

- 3) Angels point us to God; the Holy Spirit unites us with God.
 - Angels always give glory to God, not to themselves (Revelation 19:10).
 - The Holy Spirit goes deeper—He doesn't just point, He connects (Ephesians 1:13-14, Romans 8:16)

So why does He send angels?

So why does He send angels?

- 1. To carry out His will They are His messengers and agents (Hebrews 1:14).
- 2. To display His order and glory God chooses to use angels to show His majesty in creation (Job 38:7).
- 3. To serve believers Angels minister to those who will inherit salvation (Hebrews 1:14).

Don't over-depend on angels, depend on God.

Angels remind us of God's power and care, but the Holy Spirit reminds us of God's presence in us.
