Two Classifications of Angels

1. **Unfallen Angels** – the “holy angels” who remained faithful to God. (Matt. 25:31)
2. **Fallen Angels** – those who followed Satan in rebellion. (Rev. 12:9)

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The Rebellion of Fallen Angels

- **Some angels sinned by joining Satan in rebellion against God. (Jude 6)**

Jude 6

"Alalahanin n'yo rin ang mga anghel na hindi nanatili sa dati nilang kalagayan kundi iniwan ang kanilang lugar. Ginapos ng Dios ang mga iyon ng mga kadenang hindi mapuputol, at ikinulong sa napakadilim na lugar hanggang sa araw na hahatulan sila."

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- Originally created holy, but they misused their free will, like Lucifer.
- They followed Satan (Lucifer) in pride and disobedience (Isa. 14:12–15; Rev. 12:7–9).
- Their rebellion shows that angels, like humans, are accountable to God.

Isaias 14

12 “Nahulog ka mula sa langit, ikaw na tinatawag na tala sa umaga. Ibinagsak ka sa lupa, ikaw na nagpasuko ng mga bansa. **13** Sinabi mo sa iyong sarili, ‘Aakyat ako sa langit, at ilalagay ko ang aking trono sa itaas ng mga bituin ng Dios. Uupo ako sa itaas ng bundok na pinagtitipunan ng mga dios sa bandang hilaga. **14** Aakyat ako sa itaas ng mga ulap, at magiging gaya ng Kataas-taasang Dios.’

a. Bound Demons

4 Hindi pinatawad ng Diyos ang mga anghel na nagkasala. Sila'y itinapon sa impiyerno kung saan sila'y iginapos sa kadiliman upang doon hintayin ang Araw ng Paghuhukom.

- **Mark 5:1–13 - (Legion of demons in a man)**
- **1 Tim. 4:1 (“deceiving spirits and doctrines of demons”)**

b. Free Demons

**Others are free and active on earth, working
under Satan to:**

- Tempt (1 Thess. 3:5)
- Deceive with false teaching (1 Tim. 4:1)
- Oppress people spiritually, emotionally,
and physically.

How the Evil (Satan) Tempts Christians

1) Through Life's Hardships and Troubles

(1 Thess 3:4-5)

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- The devil uses suffering to make us doubt God's goodness and question His love.**

Example: “If God loves you, why are you suffering?”

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2) Through Deception and Lies

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- He tempts Christians to believe false doctrines or to compromise truth.

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3) Through Sinful Desires and Weaknesses

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- Satan studies our weaknesses and tempts us there.

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- **Sagot:** Kasi gusto niyang maging **ineffective** ang mga Kristiyano. Kapag ang isang believer ay **distracted** ng kasalanan, guilt, o maling katuruan, hindi siya makakapamuhay nang buo para sa kaluwalhatian ng Diyos.

- Para **subukin** at **patatagin** ang **pananampalataya** (James 1:2–4). Ang tuksó ay nagpapakita kung ang tiwala natin ay nasa sarili lang o talagang naka-angkla sa Salita ng Diyos.

Application for Today

- **Be alert:** Recognize that temptations aren't just random—they are part of spiritual warfare.
- **Be rooted in truth:** Knowing God's Word protects us against lies.
- **Be prayerful:** Jesus taught, “Pray that you may not enter into temptation” (Luke 22:40).
