## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. All exhibitors must be enrolled in a 4-H Horse Project. They must be active members of the 4-H club in their county or conducting the project under the direction of an adult volunteer approved by their Extension Agent. The membership of each club is responsible for determining "active membership".
2. Entry fee is \$15.00 per animal / exhibitors. Each exhibitor is limited to two animals.
3. Exhibitor's must have possession, ownership, and/or have cared for the project animal they are exhibiting by May 1, 2018, with declaration of project animal. (This ownership date is 90 days prior to the State 4H Horse Show, which complies with their regulations).
4. The exhibitor must submit a copy of a current Coggins Test dated within one year of the show with Entry Form
5. Any discourtesy to judges or show officials will result in immediate disqualification of rider and horse in question.
6. We reserve the right to combine and/or divide classes.
7. USEF, AQHA, and 4H Rules Apply.
8. No stallions, foals, or horses with mean habits can be shown.
9. Points for Championships are: 1st --5 points, 2nd --4 points, 3rd --3 points, 4th --2 points, 5th --1 point.
10. Premiums will be: 1st --\$6, 2nd --\$5, 3rd --\$4, 4th --\$3, 5th --\$2, 6th --\$1.
11. Premiums on Showmanship classes will be: 1st --\$12, 2nd --\$10, 3rd --\$8, 4th --\$6, 5th --\$4, 6th --\$2.
12. **Hard Hats must be worn at ALL times per state 4H Policy.**
13. Class order may be determined by entries.
14. Pony Hunter and Equitation O/F: Small/Medium ponies 13.2 hands and under will jump 2'3". Large ponies over 13.2 hands, but not over 14.2 hands, will jump 2'6".
15. Intermediate Hunter and Equitation O/F. Horses are over 14.2H, and may choose fence height of 2'6" or 3'
16. Pairs Class -open to all. Walk, Trot. To be judged as a pair.
17. High point awards are counted towards the horse and rider combination. Classes 26 & 27 points will not count towards high point rider.
18. Schooling permitted from 8:15am – 8:45am. There will be a 30-min schooling break after the Showmanship classes.
