- 0-02 Cabbage (1), any variety
- 0-03 Carrots (6), any variety
- 0-04 Cucumbers (3), any variety
- 0-05 Hot Peppers (3), any variety
- 0-06 Pods, Lima Beans, (6), any variety
- 0-07 Onions (3), any variety
- 0-08 Red Skin Potatoes (3), any variety
- 0-09 Snap Beans (6), any variety
- 0-10 Sweet Corn (3), any variety
- 0-11 Sweet Peppers (3), any variety
- 0-12 Summer Squash (3), any variety
- 0-13 Tomatoes (3), any variety
- 0-14 White Potatoes (3), any variety
- 0-15 Zucchini Squash (3), any variety

- 0-18 Vegetable Sculpture (radishes, animals, etc)
- 0-19 Decorated Vegetable
- 0-20 Vegetable Oddity (unusual size, deformed, rare to the community)

- 0-21 Tallest Stalk of Corn, grain variety only
- 0-22 Best 6 stalks of corn
- 0-23 Longest Ear of Grain Corn
- 0-24 Quart of Oats
- 0-25 Quart of Wheat
- 0-26 Quart of Barley
- 0-27 Quart of Soybeans
- 0-28 Best 6 Stalks of Grain Sorghum

- 0-29 Hay Bale, standard size
- 0-30 Hay Bale, mini size
- 0-31 Alfalfa Bale
- 0-32 Exhibitor's Choice
