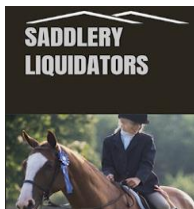

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. All exhibitors must be enrolled in a current year 4-H Horse project. They must be an active member of a 4-H club in their county. The membership of each club is responsible for determining "active membership".
2. Entry fee is \$15.00 per animal / exhibitors. Each exhibitor is limited to two animals.
3. Exhibitor's must have possession, ownership, and/or have cared for the project animal they are exhibiting by May 1, 2019, with declaration of each project animal.
4. The exhibitor must submit a copy of a current Coggins test dated within one year of the show with Entry Form
5. Any discourtesy to judges or show officials will result in immediate disqualification of rider and horse.
6. Show staff reserve the right to combine and/or divide classes.
7. USEF, AQHA, and ALL 4H Rules Apply. Class order may be determined by entries.
8. High point awards are counted towards the horse and rider combination.
9. Points for Championships are: 1st --5 points, 2nd --4 points, 3rd --3 points, 4th --2 points, 5th --1 point.
10. Premiums will be: 1st --\$6, 2nd --\$5, 3rd --\$4, 4th --\$3, 5th --\$2, 6th --\$1.
11. Premiums on Showmanship classes will be: 1st --\$12, 2nd --\$10, 3rd --\$8, 4th --\$6, 5th --\$4, 6th --\$2.
12. **Hard Hats must be worn at ALL times per state 4H Policy. Formal Show attire for respected discipline.**
13. Pleasure classes are open to all. Choose Junior or Senior pleasure division.
14. Pony Hunter and Equitation O/F: Small/Medium ponies 13.2 hands and under will jump 2'3". Large ponies over 13.2 hands, but not over 14.2 hands, will jump 2'6".
15. Low Hunter- open to horses and ponies, junior and seniors. May not cross enter into Pony Hunter or Inter. Hunter
16. Intermediate Hunter open to horses only. Open to junior and senior riders.
17. Choose ONE Equitation division- Student Eq, Junior Eq, Senior Eq.
18. Schooling permitted from 8:00am – 8:45am. 30 min schooling break after Showmanship classes.
