## RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Show is open to any Youth 5-18. Membership as a Cloverbud, 4H, or FFA member is encouraged.
2. Obtain entry forms from catalog, or www.cmrfarmshow.com and return completed with fee by June 20, 2019
3. Rabbit Department entries limited to 15 per exhibitor.
4. Rabbits will be checked in **Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup> from 5-7pm**. Animals are entered at owner's risk. Leader has the right to refuse animals deemed unfit to show. Sick animals will not be allowed in showroom. Animals will be released on **Sunday July 14<sup>th</sup> between 5:30-6:30pm**.
5. Please bring your own water bottle or crock. All animals will be feed by department leader or junior leader by 10 a.m. Show feed will be available or you can bring your own in a labeled container. Hay will also be available for show rabbits.( Donated by Maple Springs Farm). Cages must be marked if your feeding food other than what was donated.
6. We will have classes for all breeds. If your breed is not listed, please contact a leader to have it added. No rabbit under 3 months, pregnant, or with litter will be shown. Rabbit Classes will be divided by breed, sex, and age. S (Seniors) = rabbits 6 months of age or over. J (Juniors) = rabbits 3 to 6 months of age. B (Bucks) = males, and D (Does) = female.
7. All purebred classes will be judged by the American Rabbit Breeders Standard of Perfection.
8. Judging will be **10am** Sunday July 14 . **ALL EXHIBITORS** have to participate in Showmanship.
9. Entry fee: **\$2** per rabbit exhibited. There are no day of show entries. No entry fee for Cloverbuds. Cloverbuds cannot win premiums. Premiums are as follows: Showmanship Classes 1<sup>st</sup> - \$12, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$10, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$8, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$6, 5<sup>th</sup> - \$4, 6<sup>th</sup> - \$2, and all other classes 1<sup>st</sup> - \$2.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$1.50, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$1.00, 4<sup>th</sup> - .50, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> ribbons. All rabbits should be identified by tattoo or permanent marker in left ear.
