RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Show is open to any Youth 5-18. Membership as a Cloverbud, 4H, or FFA member is encouraged.
- 2. All entries are due by June 13, 2026. All entry information will be on our web site www.cmrfarmshow.com
- 3. An email with intentions to show a meat pen must be sent to Ashley Butler at amisaacson@hotmail.com no later than April 1st, 2026.
- 4. The Rabbit Department entries are limited to 15 rabbits and 1 meat pen per exhibitor.
- 5. Rabbits will be checked in on **Thursday**, **July** 9th **from** 10am-12pm or from 5-7pm. Animals are entered at owner's risk. Leaders have the right to refuse animals deemed unfit to show. Meat Pen rabbits will all be weighed at check in in the presence of the department head. Sick animals will not be allowed in the showroom. Animals will be released on **Sunday July** 12th between 5:30-6:30pm.
- 6. Please bring your own water bottle or crock. All animals will be fed by the department leader or junior leader by 10 a.m. Rabbit feed will be available, or you can bring your own in a labeled container. Cages must be marked if you are feeding food other than what was donated.
- 7. We will have classes for all breeds. If your breed is not listed, please contact a leader to have it added. No rabbit under 3 months, pregnant, or with litter will be shown. Rabbit Classes will be divided by breed, sex, and age. Sr (Seniors) = rabbits 6 months of age or over. Jr (Juniors) = rabbits 3 to 6 months of age. B (Bucks) = males, and D (Does) = female.
- 8. All purebred classes will be judged by the American Rabbit Breeders Standard of Perfection.
- 9. A meat pen consists of three rabbits, all of the same breed and variety. Broken groups must also be the same variety. A meat pen does not necessarily have to come from the same litter. Each rabbit in the meat pen must be no older than 10 weeks (70 days) by July 9th. This means meat pen rabbits must be born on or after May 1st, 2026. The minimum weight at weigh in is 3 lbs 8 oz and the maximum weight is 5 lbs 8 oz. Meat pens will be judged to the American Rabbit Breeders Associations' Standards of judging meat rabbit classes.
- 10. Judging will be **10am** Sunday July 12th. **ALL EXHIBITORS** have to participate in Showmanship. The exhibitor must be present at the show table while their rabbit is being judged. If the rabbit wins Best of Breed, the rabbit can only be qualified to compete for Best in Show if the exhibitor is still present and places the rabbit on the show table themselves. A costume class is being added. Dress your rabbit up at the end of the show.
- 11. The only schedule accommodations that will be considered are other CMR activity schedule conflicts. Any CMR schedule conflicts must be discussed and approved by the department heads before Sunday, July 13th.
- 12. Entry fee: \$2 per rabbit exhibited. A meat pen is \$16 of which \$10 is the sale fee and \$6 entry fee. No late entries will be accepted. No entry fee for Cloverbuds. Cloverbuds cannot win premiums. Premiums are as follows: Showmanship Classes 1st \$24, 2nd \$20, 3rd \$16, 4th \$12, 5th \$8, 6th \$4, and all other classes 1st \$4.00, 2nd \$3.00, 3rd \$2.00, 4th 1.00, 5th and 6th ribbons. All rabbits should be identified by a tattoo or permanent marker in their left ear.

Part 1: Rabbit Judging Contest

- 1. There will be 4 classes of 4 rabbits for participants to judge and place on their own. There will be a 7-minute time limit for judging each breed. Participants will write down their placements to hand in for scoring.
- 2. The rabbits will be placed ahead of time by a judge using the American Rabbit Breeders Association (ARBA) Standard of Perfection (SOP).

Part 2: Rabbit Breed Identification Contest

1. Participants will be asked to identify 24 rabbits. Juniors and Intermediates will fill out the complete breed name and the registration variety of each Rabbit. Seniors will fill out the complete breed name, registration variety, showroom variety, and the class. There will be a 20 minute time limit to complete the breed ID contest. The skillathon results will be announced at the awards ceremony on Monday.
