Phil mentioned that we need storage shelves. Clubhouse maintenance funds are available. Commissioners recommend that we continue to use Clubhouse fund for small items and only use maintenance fund for larger maintenance items.

Cost is approx. \$35,000. A 4th spot treatment is recommended if there are areas that need more treatment. (\$12,000). 2 warrant articles will be presented, recommended by both commissioners. (These treatments target the water shield and the floating lilies)

Cause for outage: One of the relief valves failed. We have a brand new booster pump for \$2600.

Three weeks we have been asking for information from Aquamen, to prepare for the budget.

Plowing is going well.

Treasurers report

3 customers more than 60 days late
